

COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS

Earn college credit while in high school.

An opportunity for students to earn high school and college credit through courses offered in the high school and on a college campus.

Who's eligible? Students who will be entering grades 7-12 for the 2024-25 academic year *may* be eligible to participate in College Credit Plus (CCP). Students must gain acceptance to a participating college or university AND meet their entrance testing requirement.

College Credit Plus courses earn high school AND college credit with the grades earned being calculated in high school GPA and rank. NOTE: The student/parent will be expected to reimburse the district all costs for any CCP course in which the students fails to complete the college course either through withdrawal or nonattendance OR if the student earns a failing grade in the college course.

INFORMATIONAL MEETING: Students and parents should attend the county-wide CCP informational meeting scheduled for January 10, 2024 at 6:30 PM at the Kuss Auditorium. Representatives from local colleges and universities will be available to talk with students/parents starting at 5:30. The powerpoints from the informational meeting will be available for viewing on the KR website for those who were not able to attend the meeting.

APRIL 1 DEADLINE: The Ohio Department of Education has set April 1 as the deadline for students to submit a signed "Intent to Participate" form to their high school guidance office in order to be eligible to participate in College Credit Plus the upcoming academic year. **This form is required for courses taken at the high school for college credit** as well as those taken at the college. ***NOTE: SUBMITTING THIS FORM BY THE DEADLINE IS REQUIRED FOR ALL STUDENTS EVEN FOR THOSE WHO PARTICIPATED IN COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS THE PREVIOUS ACADEMIC YEAR.***

Step 1: All students wanting to participate in College Credit Plus for the 2024-25 school year (even if they participated in 2024-25) can meet the information and counseling requirement by attending the Informational Meeting which will be held in January/February every year. There will be two components – general information about CCP and information about CCP at Kenton Ridge. The powerpoints from both components will be available on the KR website after the Informational Meeting is held. One powerpoint is general information about College Credit Plus that applies to all Ohio students; the other is specific to Kenton Ridge.

Step 2: Submit the "Intent to Participate" form to the Guidance Office, with parent and student signature, on or before April 1. This is a deadline established by the Ohio Department of Education. This form **MUST** be submitted by the deadline to be eligible to take ANY courses through the CCP program in 2024-25 including summer 2024. NOTE: April 1, 2024 is the Monday we return from Spring Break.

Step 3: Be sure to meet the application and testing requirements for the college(s) you plan to attend or earn credit from. All of the CCP courses offered at KR are through Clark State so the Clark State application and testing requirements need to be met for the CCP courses at KR.

EXAMPLES OF COLLEGE CREDIT PLUS PATHWAYS

Note: All of following CCP courses have been approved, or are in the process of being approved, for college credit awarded by Clark State Community College **to be offered at Kenton Ridge!** With these courses your student can earn college credit without giving up their high school experience. There are other CCP options available and these pathways are examples only; students will need to work with the high school counselor and college advisor to determine courses most beneficial to their college and career goals.

THIS ALLOWS KR STUDENTS TO EARN COLLEGE CREDIT WITHOUT TRAVELING TO THE COLLEGE, WITHOUT GIVING UP THEIR HIGH SCHOOL EXPERIENCE AND OPPORTUNITIES. STUDENTS ALSO HAVE DAILY ACCESS TO THEIR CCP TEACHERS AT KR WHICH ALLOWS FOR EASY ACCESS FOR COMMUNICATION AND ASSISTANCE.
