INTRODUCTION BONNIE BRADY, MASHPEE MIDDLE-HIGH SCHOOL PRINCIPAL

We are pleased to introduce you to Bonnie Brady, our Mashpee Middle-High School Principal beginning July 1, 2024. Ms. Brady is an educator with more than nine years of experience in building-based leadership. For the past twenty years, Ms. Brady has dedicated her career to the Brockton Public Schools, her alma mater, and the school district that "raised her." Throughout her career as an educator and leader in the Brockton Public Schools, Ms. Brady has cultivated strong relationships with all stakeholders, ensured a safe and orderly learning environment, honored diversity through inclusive practices, and, through her practices, demonstrated a belief that all students can excel. She is a proactive and strategic problem-solver who keeps students in the forefront of decision-making, and we are excited to welcome her to Team Mashpee.

Ms. Brady holds a Bachelor of Arts in English from Bridgewater State College, a Master of Arts in Teaching from the University of Massachusetts, and she has completed post-graduate course work in Educational Leadership and Policy Studies at the University of Massachusetts. Ms. Brady taught English at Brockton High School for nine years. During eight of those years, she also served as the International Baccalaureate (IB) Coordinator. After teaching for nine years, Ms. Brady then became the Associate Principal of Curriculum and Instruction at the Plouffe Middle School in Brockton, a position she held for nine years. She is currently the Associate Principal of Academics at Brockton High School.

Input collected from surveying our MMHS students, staff, and parents/guardians in regards to the Portrait of our Mashpee Middle-High School Principal, informed us that stakeholders want a leader who is kind, fair, has integrity, is an effective communicator and a problem-solver. They want a principal who will build/maintain a positive school climate, who has strong communication and interpersonal skills, who values stakeholder voice, and who honors diversity, provides equity, and ensures inclusion. Expertise in curriculum, instruction, and assessment and successful experience as a middle-high school teacher and administrator are also important to our stakeholders. Ms. Brady embodies this Portrait of a Mashpee Middle-High School Principal. She expressed in her interview and on-site follow-up visit how important it is to make connections and to build positive relationships with all students, all families, our staff, and our Mashpee community. Her experience working with diverse student populations, her ability to make timely and data-informed decisions, her humor, her positivity, and the importance she places on leading by example will positively impact not only the Mashpee Middle-High School, but also the greater MPS and Mashpee community.

Ms. Brady shared that when her own high school experience was challenging, the Fine Arts Department is what "saved" her and made her feel like she belonged. She plans to be the "biggest cheerleader" for the Mashpee Middle-High School, helping to highlight and celebrate everything MMHS. Principal Brady will be another reason why it's GREAT to be in MASHPEE.

2024 MMHS DIVERSITY DAY HOSTED BY SENIOR LILA BURKE








PROGRAM OF STUDIES DAY FOR STUDENTS & EVENING FOR FAMILIES






