- There will be volunteer opportunities for Book Fair that will be sent home soon as well.
- The PTC will be doing a round up raffle again this year.
 - If your child's total is \$9.75 and they have \$10, your child can round up their total to receive a raffle ticket to enter to win a basket of books.
 - The money collected from the round up raffle goes in the library fund.

Art & Music Night
