

SAT Testing Update for 11th Graders:



 Students will receive information next week in their language arts classes about how to opt-in to the SAT with Essay option for the SAT offered at FHS on April 16th. This is optional, students must opt-in by February 15th.

PSAT9 / PSAT10 / SAT / CMAS SCI 11 Update for 9th-11th Graders:

- Students will be asked to fill out a form next week in their language arts classes to indicate what device they plan to use during testing. This will help us prepare school devices and ensure we have loaners.
- For PSAT and SAT testing: students may use a personal windows and mac laptops and tablets, BVSD 1:Web chromebook, or a school loaner chromebook
- For CMAS SCI 11: students can only use a BVSD 1:Web chromebook or school loaner chromebook.
- If your student has a BVSD 1:Web chromebook that needs repair, they should stop by the library as soon as possible to ensure it is repaired by testing.




