English 12 (Required Credits: 1.00)

U.S. History=>World History=>U.S. Civics & Government=>Social Studies Elective Choice(s)

Mathematics 12 (Recommended Credits: 1.00)

Four mathematics credits are required for graduation. Seniors who have not met the requirement must schedule all needed math credits. From the following list, they should request the next course in the sequence:

Algebra 1=>Geometry=>Algebra 2

For special education students, there is an additional choice, Foundations of Mathematics 12.

Science 12 (Recommended Credits: 1.00)

Four science credits are required for graduation. Seniors who have not met the requirement must schedule all needed science credits. From the following list, they should request the next course(s) in the sequence:

ETL=>Biology=>Chemistry
