

## **Piper Stadium Reminders**

No outside food or drink allowed. This includes water, soda or sports drink bottles or cans; Yeti/Stanley or similar cups or fast food drink cups; or paper or plastic coffee cups. If you come to the gates with any of these items, you will be required to return them to your car or throw them away.

Adults with a ticket stub may re-enter the stadium if it becomes necessary to leave the stadium and return. Students who leave the game must pay to re-enter.

PK-5th students must be accompanied by and sit with their parent/guardian/designated adult. We will contact parents to pick up students in 5th grade and below who attempt to enter without their parent/guardian/designated adult.

Elementary students who are not being supervised by their parent/guardian/designated adult as mentioned above will be asked by a district leadership team member or police officer to return to their parent/guardian/designated adult, and will be expected to comply with that request.

The following items are not allowed in Piper Stadium: airhorns, bullhorns, whistles, other artificial noisemakers, footballs, soccer balls or other sports equipment.

No animals (other than service animals) are allowed in the stadium.

Students are prohibited from gathering, running, throwing objects, or engaging in rough play in the vicinity of the gates, concession area, track, baseball field, and grassy area near the south endzone.

Engaging in prohibited conduct, including congregating in prohibited areas or failure to comply with requests of members of the district leadership team or police can result in removal from the game.

Absolutely no alcohol, drugs, smoking, vaping, tobacco, or firearms on school property at any time, including before, during and after football games in the stadium and parking lots. These are prohibited by law at all times for anyone, no matter their age, on school property.
