Camp KUUMBA Session One is open to current 2nd-3rd graders. Camp KUUMBA Session Two is open to current 4th-5th graders. Camp KUUMBA Session Three is open to current 6th-7th grade (boys). Space is limited.

- Session II Current 4th/5th grade boys and girls- July 1st-19th 7:30am-5pm (breakfast and lunch provided)
- Session III Current 6th/7th grade boys only- July 1st-19th 7:30am-5pm (breakfast and lunch provided)
