

## THE UC SYSTEM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS



- A-G requirements
- Minimum GPA to apply: 3.0 or higher
- Competitive GPA: 3.96 4.26 (w)
- 4 short-answer essays (PIQ's)
- Brag sheet
- Application fee: \$80 (per campus) or fee waiver (based on family income/household size)



# THE UC SYSTEM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

#### **ACADEMIC:**


- A-G requirements
- **Minimum GPA to apply**: 3.0 or higher
- **Competitive GPA**: 3.96 4.26 (W)

#### **SUPPLEMENTAL:**

- Awards or honors
- Extracurricular activities
- Volunteer/community service
- Work experience
- 4 personal insight essays (PIQ's)

Note: SAT or ACT scores will not be considered for admission purposes.

- Opens: AUGUST 1
- Deadline to apply: NOVEMBER 30
- 4 PIQ essays and college resume (brag sheet) <u>required</u>.

  - 92% graduate within 6 years






#### **UC BERKELEY (UCB)**

  - > 87% graduate within 6 years






#### **UC SANTA BARBARA (UCSB)**






#### **UC DAVIS (UCD)**

  - 76% graduate within 6 years






#### **UC MERCED (UCM)**
