




A Part of History





Saint John's Catholic Prep

Who would have predicted, in the late 1700's, that an 8000 acre parcel of land known as Red Hill would later become the location of our school? Daniel Dulaney laid out the city called Fredericktowne and built the original home on this property, though the current mansion, known as Prospect Hall, was probably not completed until 1810. This white, three story structure was designed in a Greek Revival style and was widely known as the most important home in western Maryland. Located on the highest elevation in Frederick, this estate has hosted many important people, from George Washington and Harry Truman to John F. Kennedy. Immediately before the Battle of Gettysburg in 1863, the mansion was the site of General Meade's takeover of the Army of the Potomac from General Joseph Hooker. In 1958, the Archdiocese of Baltimore bought the estate and opened St. John's Literary Institution at Prospect Hall. In the early 1970's, the school became an independent Catholic school and in 2006, the school's name was changed to Saint John's Catholic Prep. So much has taken place on these grounds. This yearbook will document our part of the history of this beautiful











Saint John's has a remarkably long and distinguished history of academic excellence?

May 1782 - John McElroy, founder of St. John's Literary Institution, was born in Euniskillen, Ireland. He immigrated to America at the age of twenty-one, settling first in Baltimore, Maryland, and then in Washington, D.C., where he entered the Jesuit Order at Georgetown.

Circa 1803 -1810- The large, elegant mansion later known as Prospect Hall and the future site of St. John's Literary Institution was constructed on Red Hill in Frederick, Maryland

Father McElroy founded Saint John's on 2nd Street in Frederick, Maryland. He also founded the first free school for black children in Washington D.C. and founded Boston College in 1865. The Charter of St. John's Literary Institution was obtained from Maryland State Legislature in 1829.

St. John's Literary Institution became coeducational, with the School Sisters

of Notre Dame helping staff the parish school.

The Archdiocese of Baltimore bought Prospect Hall and St. John's Literary Institution moved grades 9 to 12 from the downtown Frederick location to the acquired building.

The School Sisters of Notre Dame were no longer able to staff the school, so a group of dedicated parents and parishioners pooled their energies and resources to keep the school open. Through their dedication, St. John's remained open as the first independent, Catholic School in Maryland.

Prospect Hall Mansion was placed on the National Register of Historic Places. A Sesquicentennial Celebration Ball was held for St. John's Literary Institution.

St. John's Literary Institution at Prospect Hall was renamed Saint John's 2006-Catholic Prep in anticipation of relocating the school a few miles away to Buckeystown, Maryland.



Do you recognize this? It is one of the windows above the doors of the mansion. They are called an elliptical fanlights and are original to the building. They are very unusual because they are the Federal style of architecture and the mansion is built in the Greek Revival style. They were extremely expensive and only the very wealthy had them in their homes. They were a huge status symbol of the time!

George Washington and Blueskin




George Washington's wife Martha was a widow with children when he married her. Her daughter was married to Daniel Dulaney's son, the first owner of the estate. Washington visited the Dulaney family during the Revolutionary War and was given the horse named Blueskin that he rode during the war. Washington loved Blueskin so much that, when the war ended, he returned him so he could live out his days in the pasture where he had been born. It has long been told that Blueskin is buried in the front yard of the mansion! Legend has it that Blueskin's spirit wanders the grounds every year on George Washington's birthday!

The Story of A

Agnes served at the Prospect Hall estate as a servant girl soon after the American Revolution. It was discovered that Christopher Dulaney, the son of the owner, Daniel Dulaney the younger, engaged in an affair with Agnes. Dulaney's parents were outraged, as it was extremely taboo for a man of privilege to associate with a lowly housemaid. Dulaney's mother was particularly angry and as a result, she sent Christopher to France. Meanwhile, Agnes pleaded her innocence, but to no avail. Mrs. Dulaney had Agnes buried alive in the wall that now separates the faculty room and the president's office. Ever since, the ghost of Agnes has been seen in Prospect Hall and numerous cases of unexplained activity have been reported.




Did you know...

Did you know...

information on weather goes back a long time in the Mid-Atlantic region, thanks to early record keeping by weather observers such as Benjamin Franklin, George Washington and Thomas Jefferson?! From January 27-28, 1772, a storm named the "Washington and Jefferson Snow Storm," since both of their diaries recorded it, left 30 to 36 inches of snow in Baltimore and Washington. Official weather records in this area did not begin until after the Civil War in 1883-1884. Therefore, the 1772 storm is not listed in the record books, but it did produce the greatest snow this region had seen since the early settlements. People were unable to travel anywhere for two weeks due to the deep snow-pack left by the storm. It took 5 weeks for postal service to resume because the horses couldn't get around! This season, the snow destroyed the previous records and dumped 72.3 inches in Baltimore and 54.9 inches in Washington, D.C.! Mother Nature deposited even more snow on the Frederick area. Our campus was buried! With the first snowfall coming before Christmas, followed by back-to-back blizzards in February, school was closed for weeks! We all enjoyed lots of shoveling and time-off and returned to "making up for lost time" in the classrooms! Spring of 2010 looks to be the most anticipated season ever!










The campus of Saint John's Catholic Prep was buried under nearly 4 feet of snow with drifts that climbed much higher!
