

















# The One and Only...




# FOOTBALL




# BOYS' LACROSSE








## Saint John's Catholic Prep **Athletic Hall of Fame**

Haley Scott DeMaria, author of the book, accepted Brian's invitation and spoke to the Saint John's school community on Wednesday, February 23, 2011. She shared her story of the 1992 Notre Dame Women's Swim Team bus accident. The accident resulted in two fatalities and left Haley paralyzed from the waist down.
