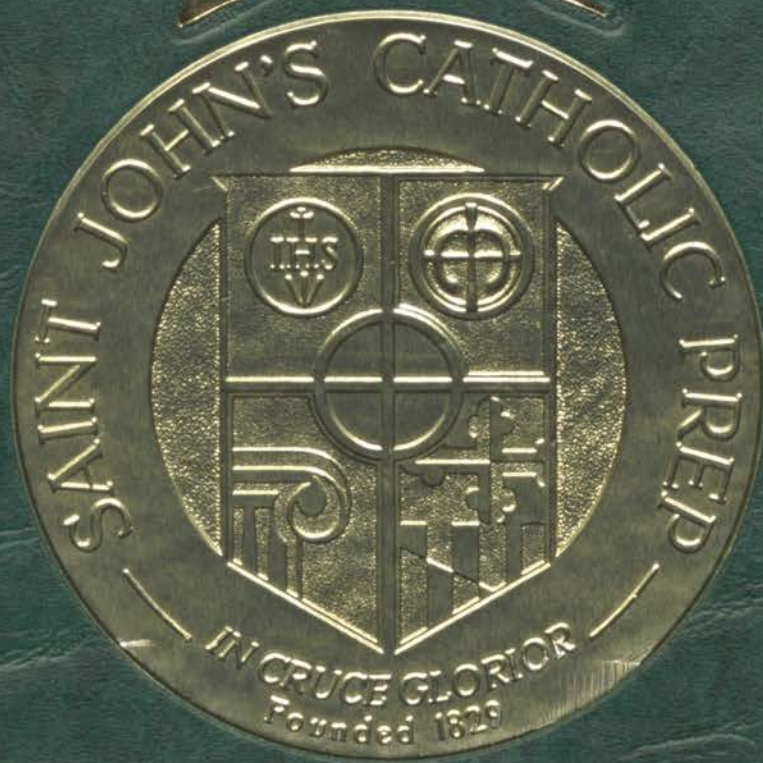
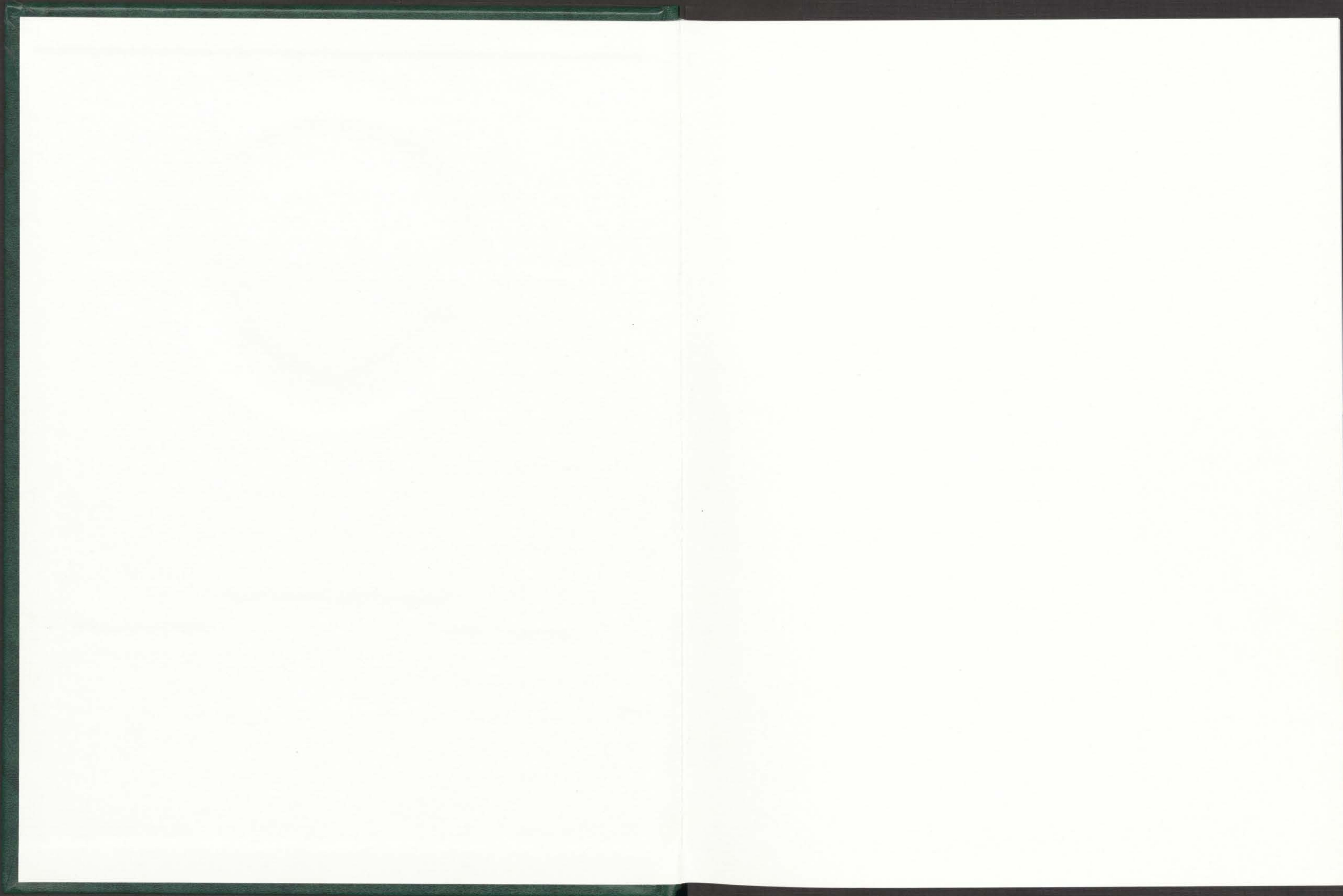

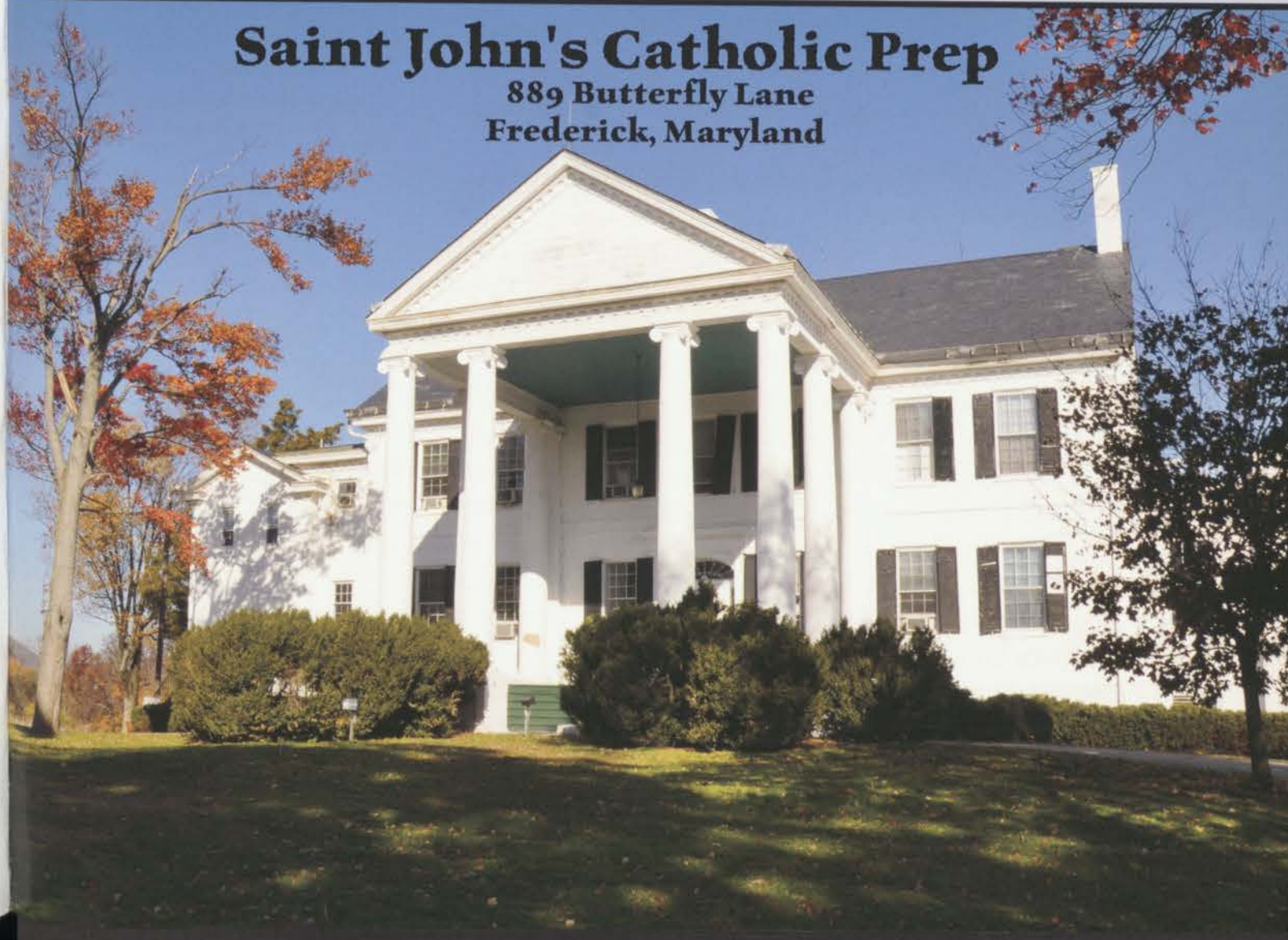


# ~VIKING FACE BOOK~

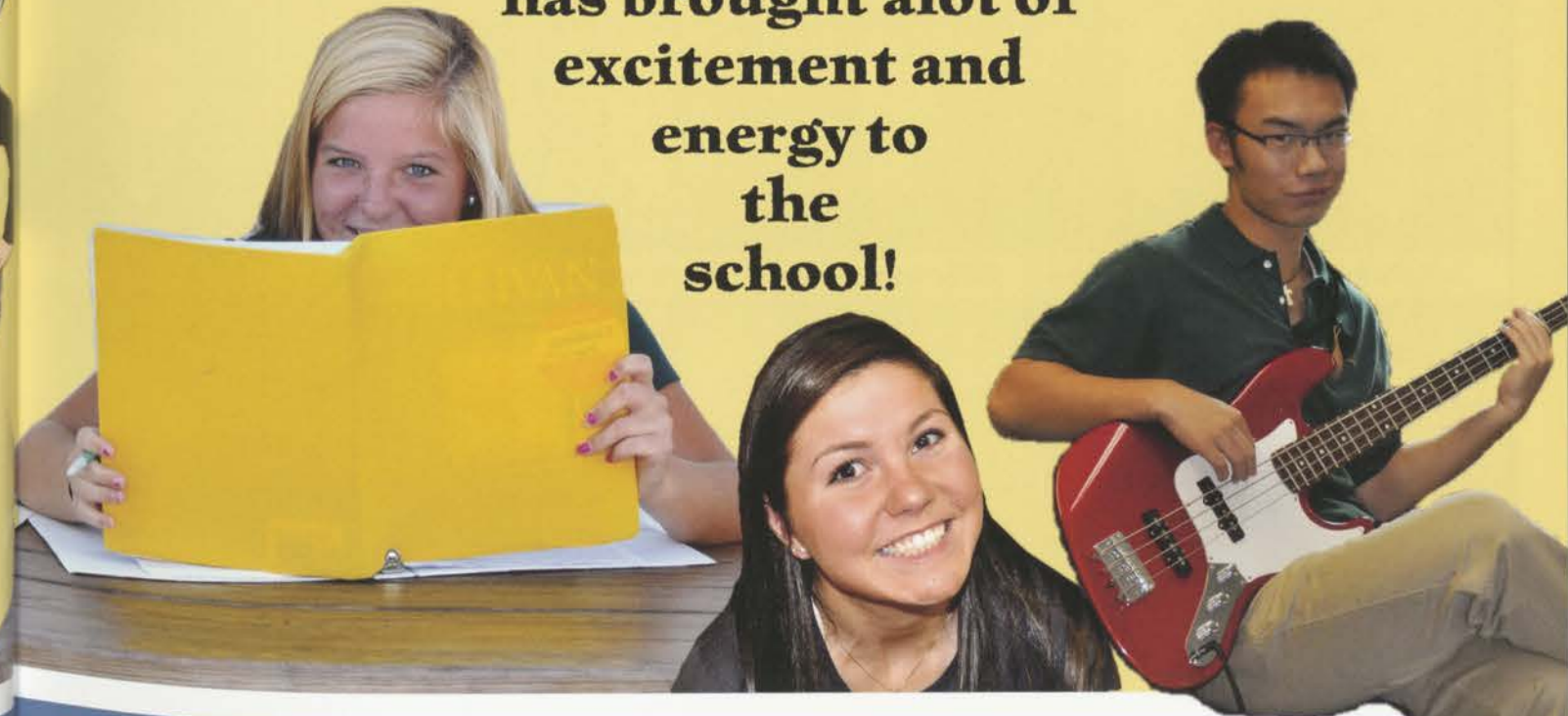




JUNIORS...CLASS of 2012

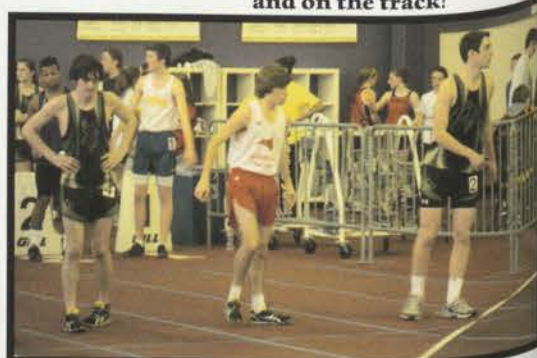


# Never Look Back... INDOOR TRACK

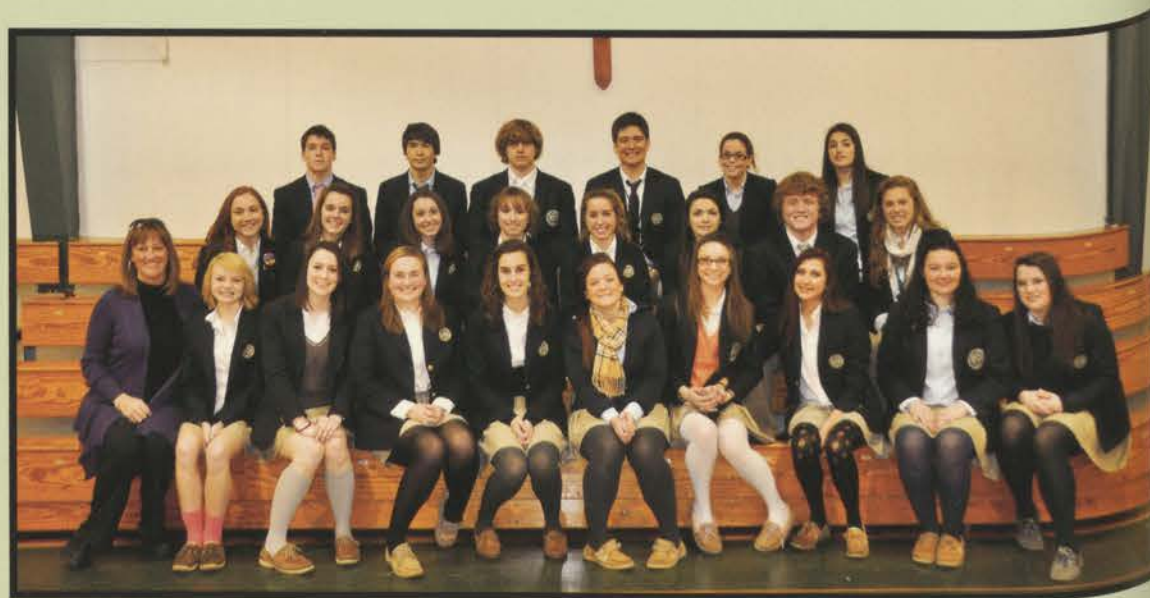
# Clubs & Organizations

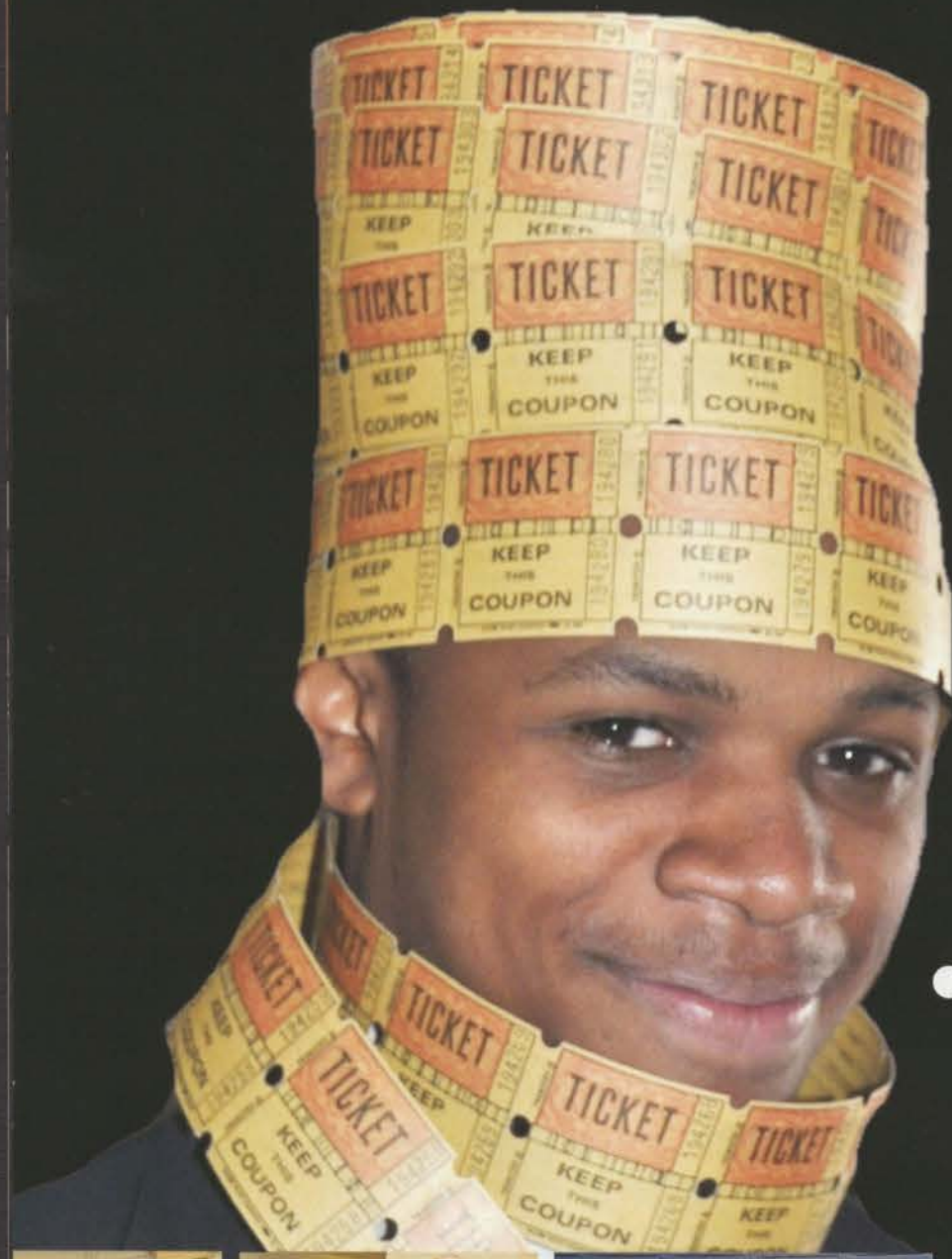
## A JOURNEY OF FAITH AND TRIUMPH



Truth is...junior, Brian Plamondon, recently read a book called "What Though the Odds." He was inspired by the book and contacted the author and invited her to speak at a school assembly. Haley Scott DeMaria, author of the book, accepted Brian's invitation and spoke to the Saint John's school community on Wednesday, February 23, 2011. She shared her story of the 1992 Notre Dame Women's Swim Team bus accident. The accident resulted in two fatalities and left Haley paralyzed from the waist down. After a miraculous recovery and intense rehabilitation, in October 1993, Haley returned to Notre Dame's swim team. She competed again for the Fighting Irish and won her first race after returning from the accident. She has received several national awards as a result of her inspiring recovery. In June 2008, Haley published "What Though the Odds - Haley Scott's Journey of Faith and Triumph," to chronicle her physical and emotional journey back from paralysis. Her message about "never giving up" was heartfelt and inspiring.

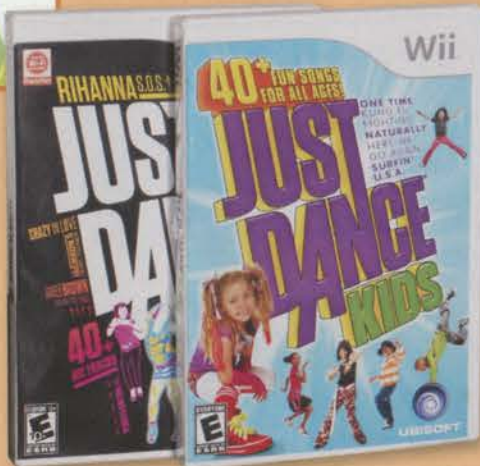
