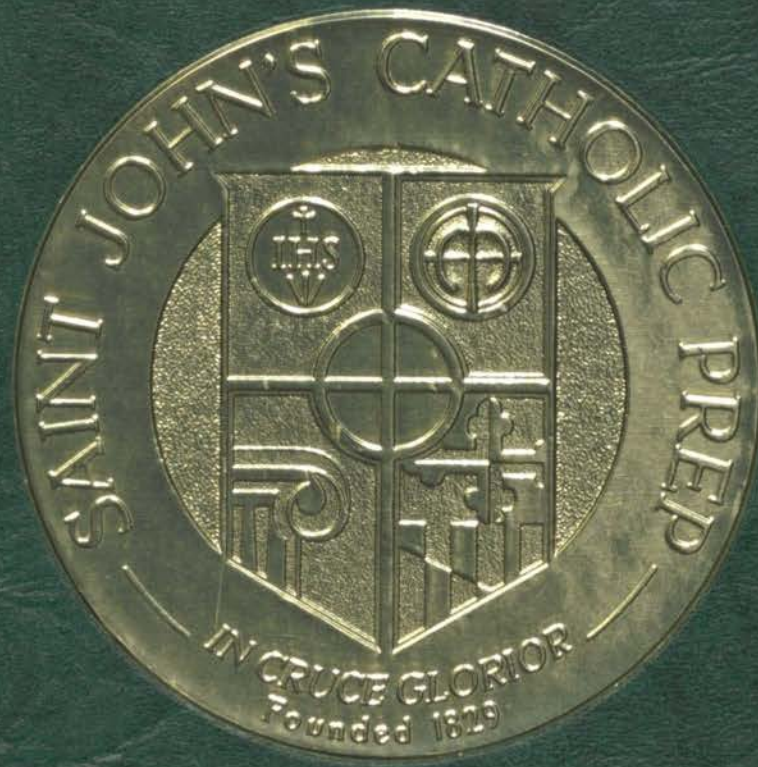

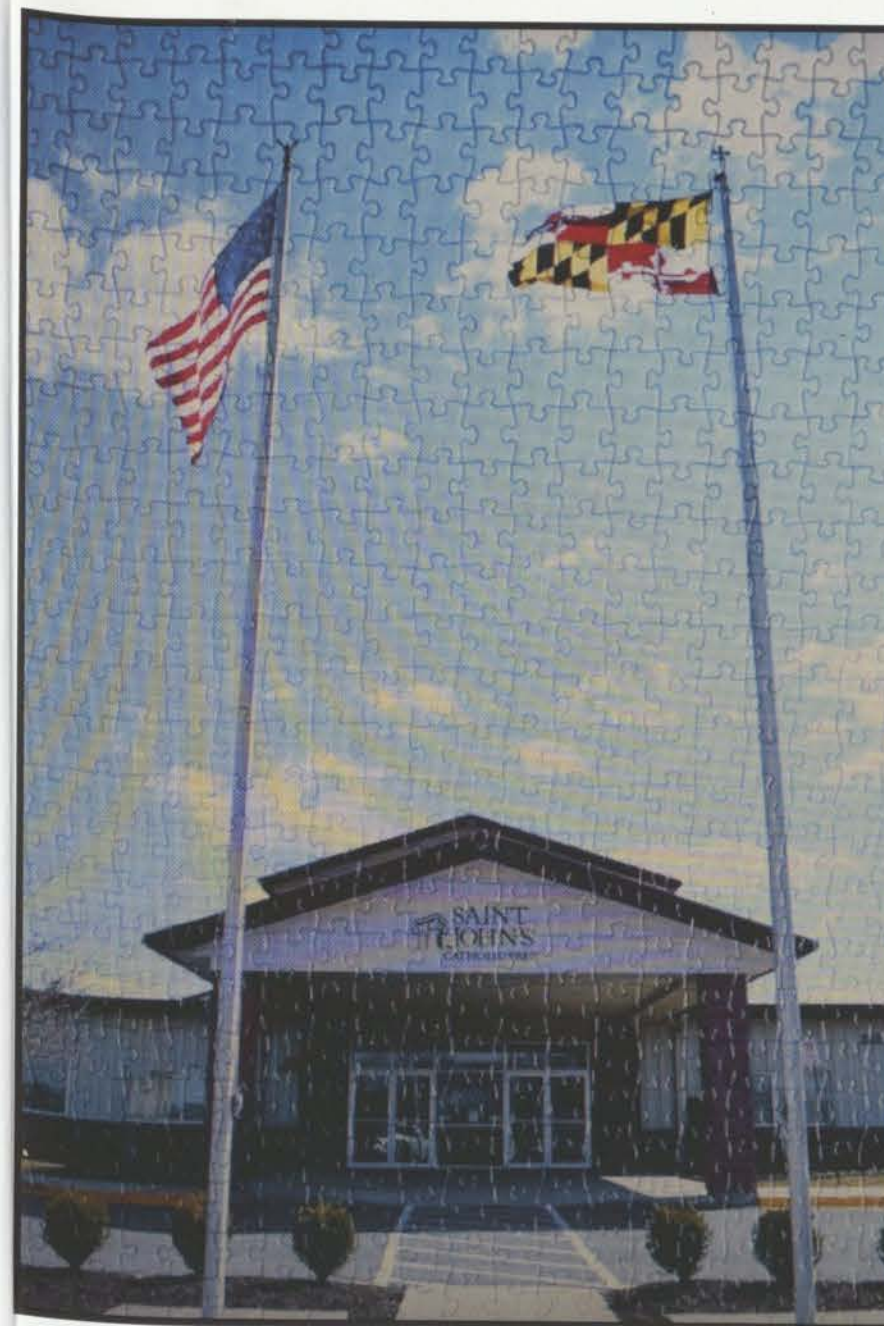

From an historic perspective, St. John's Literary Institution has many pieces that we have been putting together over the years: from our founding in 1829 by Father John McElroy as an all-boys school in downtown Frederick, to the integration of female students in 1915 by Father William Kane, to the move in 1959 to the Prospect Hall mansion.

In recent years, the pieces have included a new name and a new home in Buckeystown. And even though we've been at 3989 Buckeystown Pike for 28 months, we are still putting together new programs and adding to our school facilities. Our dual credit program with FCC adds another dimension to the education we provide, as does our Kane program for students with learning differences. The new school stage provides additional opportunities and is yet another piece in the overall make-up of our school. The idea of putting something together like this yearbook, piece by piece, implies a process that is slow but deliberate.

Each piece is different in design and shape but each piece plays an integral part in the overall fabric: without any one piece, the overall big picture will not be complete. And this is a fitting metaphor for SJCP. Each student, each faculty/staff person, and each member of our community, brings a unique and important aspect to the school and is what makes us more than just an educational institution. It is what makes us family and what colors the big picture historically known as St. John's Literary Institution but now and forever known as Saint John's Catholic Prep, the home of the Vikings!

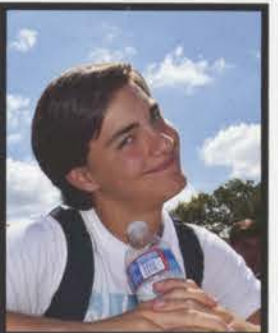


SOPHOMORES

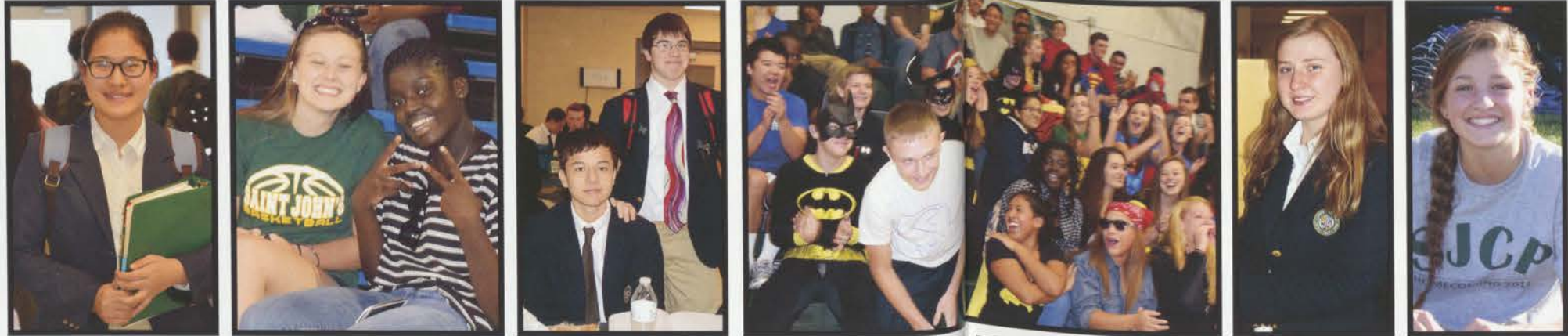


President's Corner

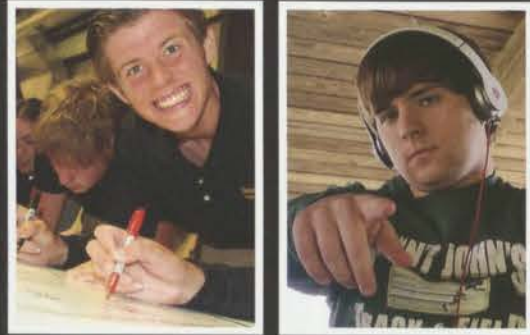


JUNIOR RING DAY!

Throughout the year, classes go out and experience new things, participate in events and view historical, scientific and artistic exhibits at museums. On a sunny day this fall, faculty and students in the Social Justice and senior English classes joined the historic event, March on Frederick, organized by Dr. Olivia White at Hood College. This event honored the 51st anniversary of the 1963 March on Washington and commemorated the 50th anniversary of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. Over a thousand people marched several miles through the streets of Frederick and finished at the college campus. The actual process of marching had a profound effect on many of the students as they felt what it must have been like for those brave and strong enough to stand up for their rights so many decades ago. These are fantastic opportunities for our students and some of the amazing activities they have enjoyed and learned from this year include: harvesting and planting crops with Farmer Mike at the Seed of Life Farm, a day filled with museums and the 9/11 Memorial in New York City, the Right to Life March in Washington, D.C., a band concert for the elderly at Buckingham's Choice Retirement Community, viewing artifacts at the Boonsboro Civil War Museum and Antietam Battlefield, taking pictures of animals, rivers and downtown Frederick, packing bags full of food for disadvantaged students at one of the local public schools, enjoying the beauty and creativity of art museums, participating in both a poverty simulation at Frederick Community College and the Shoah Holocaust Conference and many more. Watching our students' excitement and passion as they take on new challenges, actively learn things in new ways and stand up for what they believe in, is so gratifying and inspiring to witness.

Piecing Our Year Together With Assemblies, Masses, Drives and Events!

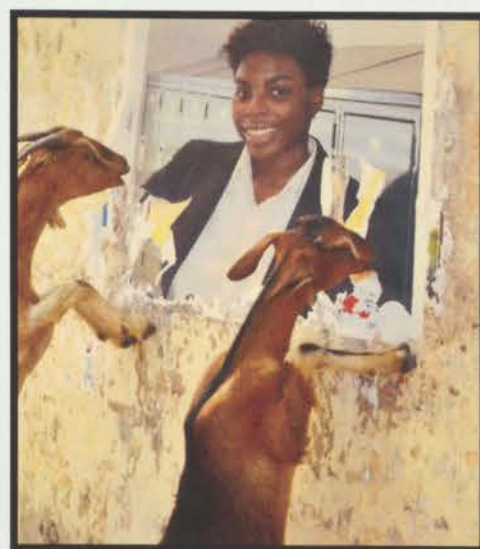
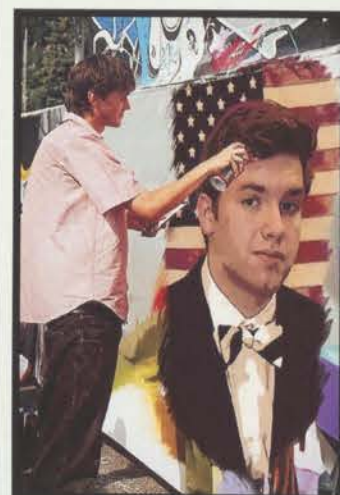
