Some of the members of NHS participate in a after school tutoring program throughout the week for various subjects while others are involved in a special community service group.








McSherry Maniacs

donated the money for the gym. This is a way to combine part of the school's history with the excitement of basketball in the new Plamondon Gymnasium!






















