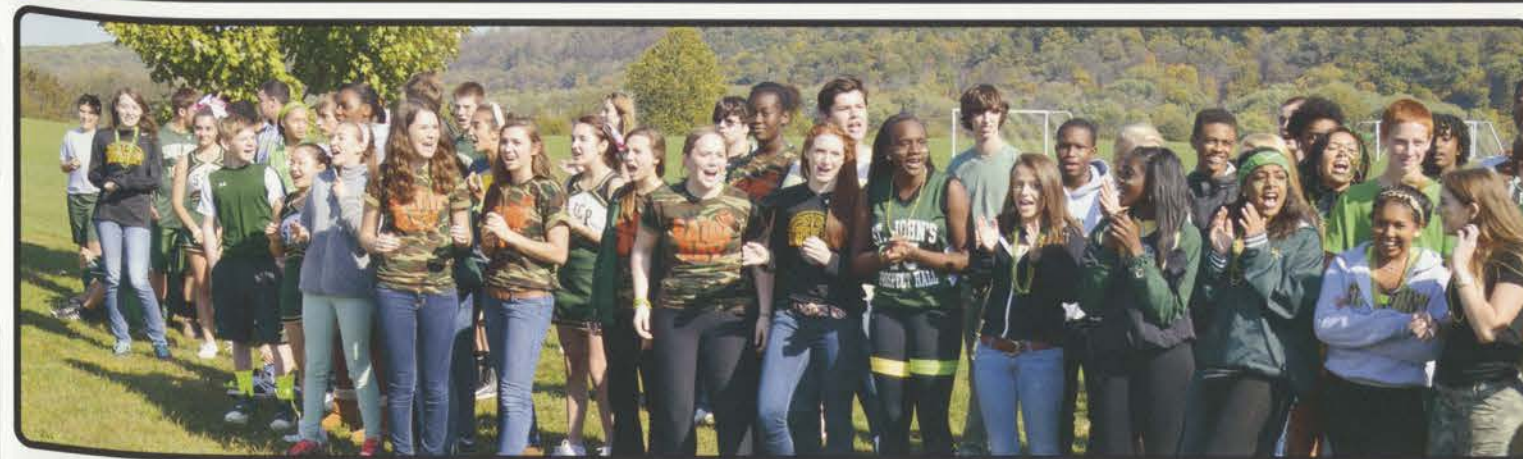




Sophomores * of * 2016

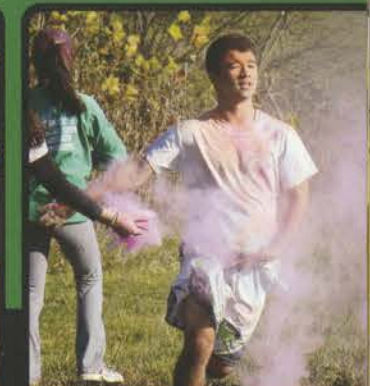
The Color Run!

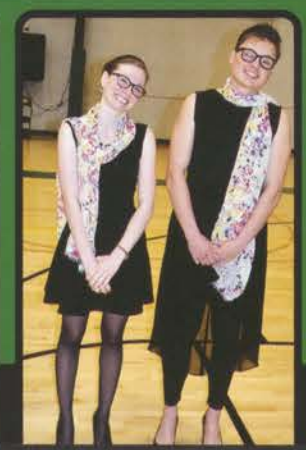
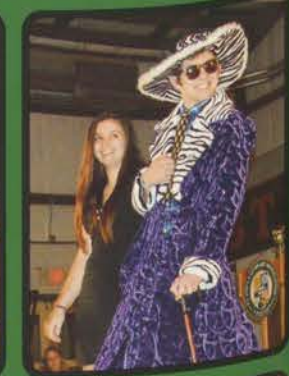
"MR. VIKING 2014" MICHAEL GRUS!
