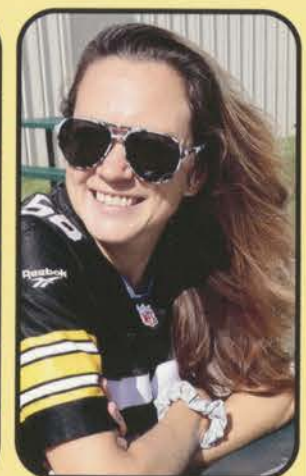
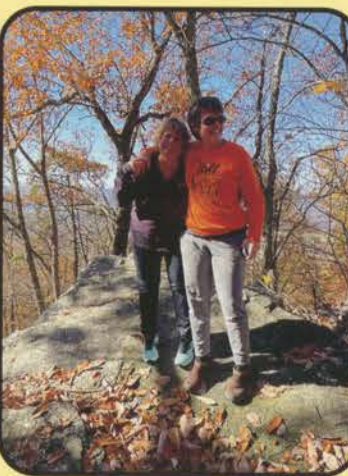
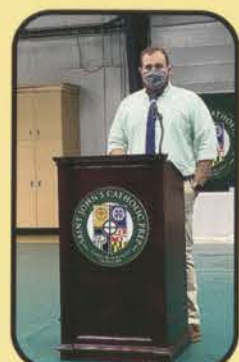
DR. ERIN SMITH TEACHER OF THE YEAR
