Congratulations to all students for completing the first semester! Now that we are at the halfway point, it's a great opportunity to have a conversation with your student(s) about their goals. I'd encourage you to use the following as a outline for a conversation:

- Review first semester grades with them. Ask for their input on how classes are going, and what courses they like.
- Ask them to look back on the first semester and share any "big wins." Take time to celebrate those wins!
- Ask them to look back and share any struggles they had. Take a moment to talk through those. Encourage them to find ways to get help.
- Finally, ask them to look ahead and set achievable second semester goals. Write them down and display them prominently. Perhaps they can identify new study habits or a different approach to homework.

I hope these conversations are productive and lead to some goals for the second semester. Please reach out to the administration or specific teachers if you have questions or concerns about grades or anything else that arises. Our next parent/teacher conferences are not until February 15 and 16, but you don't need to wait until then.

At the end of January, we celebrate Catholic Schools Week. This is a nationwide celebration where all Catholic schools celebrate what makes us different. As a Catholic school, we strive to care for the whole student - not just their academic performance. We challenge your son/daughter to grow academically, spiritually, physically and socially.
