Course I: LEADING SCHOOL STRATEGY AND INNOVATION

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Course II: LEADING PEOPLE

Leading People provides school leaders with the skills needed to manage and motivate staff, foster continuous improvement, and build leadership capabilities among individuals, groups, and teams throughout the school.
