Thank you for your interest in the LULAC Mainland Council #22427 Student Scholarship. Please read the entire application and complete all requirements. Deadline to submit an application and required documents is March 31, 2024. Priority is given to students of La Marque HS, Hitchcock HS, Santa Fe HS, Dickinson HS, and College of the Mainland, dependent upon number of applications received. You can submit your application and documents one of four ways:

1. **Email** all documents to LULAC22427Scholarship@gmail.com by midnight on April 1, 2024.
2. **Mail** all documents to Marie Eliaz at 2910 31st Ave N, Texas City, TX 77590, must be postmarked by March 30, 2024. If mailed, please email the above email address to inform the committee to expect your application.
3. Submit your application and documents **online** via Jotform link: <https://form.jotform.com/240206065515043> by midnight on April 1, 2024.
4. **Hand deliver** all documents to a LULAC Council #22427 member by March 31, 2024. If hand delivered, please email the above email address to inform the committee to whom you delivered your application.

Failure to complete the application correctly and send required documentation by the stated deadlines **WILL** make your application ineligible. The scholarship committee will meet in April to select recipients and all applicants will be notified of their status. The Scholarship Banquet will be held in July 2024, details will be sent to award recipients. If you have any questions, please text Marie Eliaz at 409-457-5254.

Council #22427 Requirements:

1. High School or College transcript showing GPA. Grades and academic performance will serve as indicators of potential; however, emphasis may be placed on the individual's motivation, sincerity, and integrity, which can best be revealed through the personal essay. Community involvement and leadership activities will also be considered.
2. Student **MUST** provide eight (8) volunteer hours with a non-profit organization by March 31, 2024. Hours can be obtained July 2023 through March 2024. Examples include LULAC Mainland #22427 events, Food Bank, Church, etc. Documentation of hours must be in the form of a letter with the non-profit organization name, date/hours volunteered, description of duties and contact person name and phone.
3. Student must attend the banquet to receive scholarship award.
4. Receiving a scholarship from another Council will nullify LULAC Mainland #22427 award.
5. Student can **ONLY be awarded** one scholarship per lifetime.
6. Student must reside in Galveston County. Priority is given to students of La Marque HS, Hitchcock HS, Santa Fe HS, Dickinson HS, and C.O.M., dependent on number of applicants.
