



## 2024-2025 PCMS Transition Current 6<sup>th</sup> Grade/Rising to 7<sup>th</sup> Grade

### **Wednesday, March 20, 2024:**

#### ***Elementary parent conferences***

Grade 6 teachers will share the level recommendations (math & ELA) with parents during elementary parent conferences. Teachers will also share if they recommended any student for additional support through our Title I program, in math and ELA, in place of recommending them for a world language. PowerSchool parent/student login information will be shared during conferences. Families should hold on to this information for course registration. This login information is temporary and active only during the registration period. Families will be mailed permanent PowerSchool login information when students are sent their schedules this summer.

### **Monday, April 8, 2024:**

#### ***PCMS principal & school counselors visit the three elementary schools***

The principal and school counselors will visit the 6<sup>th</sup> graders in each elementary school and provide an overview of the middle school, the course registration process and answer any questions the students may have.

### **Monday, April 8, 2024:**

#### ***Parent Night: Transitioning to the Middle School***

Administration and school counselors will meet with the parents of incoming 7<sup>th</sup> graders to review the process and timelines for students entering the middle school. The meeting will start at 6:00pm and be held in the PCMS auditorium. Students are also welcome to attend.

### **Monday, April 29:**

#### ***PowerSchool student registration***

PCMS staff will meet with 6<sup>th</sup> grade students in each elementary school to have them register for their courses in school on April 29. If parents prefer, they can register their child themselves, using the PowerSchool login information that the 6<sup>th</sup> grade teachers shared with them at conferences, anytime from 4/8 to 4/29.

### **Mid/Late August:**

Student schedules will be mailed home along with other important beginning-of-the-year information.

### **Late August:**

The middle school will post a series of days/times when middle schoolers and their families can drop by to tour the school and see where their classrooms are located.

### **First Day of School:**

On the first day of school (the exact date for the 24-25 school calendar is tbd) there will be an orientation for the first 60 minutes. Then we will shift into following a Day 1 schedule with shortened classes until our regular student dismissal at 2:10 pm.
