In this immersive summer program at Hartford Art School (HAS), students learn how to use analogue and dark room technology in black and white photography, and integrate this special process into their photographic work. A HAS photography professor guides students in understanding 35mm cameras, film exposure, processing and printing, lab equipment, and materials.

In addition, artist lectures and guest artists introduce students to the larger photographic world, and the program culminates in a mini exhibition of student work in a professional gallery setting.
