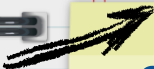

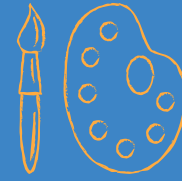

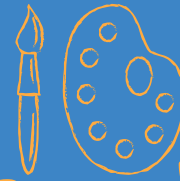

Graduating “With Honors”

To be Eligible



- You must have attended OHS for one full year directly prior to graduation and no classes taken pass/fail.



Summa Cum Laude



- Student with a 4.0 + GPA as computed at the end of 7 semesters of high school work, as well as scored above the national average on the ACT/SAT (20+) or earned the Platinum Level on the WorkKeys Assessment.



Graduating “With Honors”

Magna Cum Laude

- 3.85 to 3.99 GPA as computed at the end of 7 semesters of high school work, as well as scored above the national average on the ACT/SAT (20+) or earned the Gold Level on the WorkKeys Assessment.

Cum Laude

- 3.85 + GPA as computed at the end of 7 semesters of high school work.



Diploma AND

• Students who have met Graduation requirements

AND

Have an Updated ICAP

College & Career Exam (ACT, SAT, ASVAB, or WorkKeys)

AND

One of the following:

- A+
- College Credit (OTC, AP, IB, Dual Credit)
- Adv. Military Enlistment
- Adv. Industry Credentials (certain CTE classes)

- Vocational Rehabilitation Plan
- Work Experience (CCE/AOE)





Clearinghouse



– Eligible classes

- Regular-level or Honors English
- Regular-level or Honors Math
- Most Science classes, including electives
- Most Social Studies classes, including electives

– Ineligible classes

- Yearbook/Newspaper, Varsity Speech/Debate, Technical Reading and Writing 11th or 12th
- Concepts Math classes
- Any Fine or Practical Art, even it is used as a graduation requirement (Ex. 3rd Agriculture class substituting a Science credit)

DIVISION I ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

To study and compete at a **Division I school**, you must earn 16 NCAA-approved **core-course credits**, earn a minimum 2.3 **core-course GPA** and submit your final transcript with proof of graduation to the Eligibility Center.

CORE-COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Earn 16 NCAA-approved core-course credits in the following areas:

ENGLISH	MATH (Algebra I or higher)	SCIENCE (Including one year of lab, if offered)	ADDITIONAL (English, math or science)	SOCIAL SCIENCE	ADDITIONAL COURSES (Any area listed to the left, world language or non-doctrinal religion/philosophy)
4 years	3 years	2 years	1 year	2 years	4 years

For Division I, 10 of your 16 NCAA-approved core-course credits must be completed before the start of your seventh semester, including seven in English, math or science.

A+ Program

- Signed agreement turned into the A+ office.
- Attend a designated A+ school for at least two years prior to graduation.
- Graduate with an overall unweighted grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.
- Have at least a 95% attendance record overall for grades 9 – 12.
- Perform at least 50 hours of unpaid tutoring or mentoring. You can have this in your schedule in grades 11 or 12.
- Maintain a record of good citizenship and avoid the unlawful use of drugs and/or alcohol while in grades 9 – 12.
- Have achieved a score of proficient or advanced on the Algebra I end of course exam or an ACT Math/GPA qualifying combination.

COLLEGE NOW PROGRAM

- All OTC COLLEGE NOW classes are part of the Core 42 which will transfer to all Missouri Public Colleges or Universities.


