Student Support

In this year-long elective, we support students around campus using these four branches of restorative justice:

Peer Panel

Peer Panel is for more serious offenses on campus. The student attends a panel with four members of student support, where we work through and solve the problem. The particpiant is assigned objectives to help them learn from their mistakes and repair the harm.

<u>Peer Mediation</u>

Peer mediation is where two student support mediators work through conflict with a group of students to avoid the situation from getting worse. Two weeks later, we have a follow up meeting to make sure the conflict is resolved.

<u>Peer Mentoring</u>

Peer mentoring is for students who are struggling academically and/or socially. A student meets with a mentor to complete assignments, get organized, and much more.

<u>Community Circle</u>

Community circle is an oppurtunity for students to meet new people and share their feelings in a safe space. Everyone sits in a circle where we have different rounds that reflect on the theme of the circle.
