Years One & Two

The Career Skills program was created to provide specialneeds students with an opportunity to learn a variety of job skills in a hands-on environment. Students will explore a variety of careers, review job readiness and work ethics, and develop financial literacy and independent living. They will also review job safety for a variety of workplace activities. During year two, students will spend time rotating through the many career center programs, exploring their career interests.

Years Three & Four

Students will have the opportunity to enroll in an AKS Career Center program, may participate in a program part time, or may participate in a work-based learning program utilizing skills from their training programs. Students will have a career coach who will work alongside them. During their time in the program, students will be exposed to skills that will be beneficial for entry-level positions with many local employers.
