





SCHOOL GROUP OFFERINGS 2023/24 SEASON

STUDENT SEASON PASS \$229

For ages 6 to 22.

The off-peak student season pass is valid Mondays to Fridays anytime, and weekends/holidays after 4pm. Holidays include December 26th-January 1st, January 12th-15th, February 16th-19th.

Students registered by October 31st will receive a \$25 Blue Mountain Gift Card for free!

ADULT OFF-PEAK SEASON PASS \$500

For ages 23 +

Off-peak valid Mondays to Fridays anytime, weekends/holidays after 4pm. Holidays include December 26th-January 1st, January 12th-15th, February 16th-19th.

ALL-ACCESS SEASON PASS \$675

For ages 6+ Valid everyday all season long.

ADD-ON DAILY PICK-UP RENTALS \$90

All rentals must be picked up and returned the same day of use. If equipment is lost or stolen, the person whose name is on the rental will be charged. Their season pass will be suspended until the charge has been paid. When arriving as a group, a chaperone must accompany students to the rental area upon arrival and during the return process.

ADD-ON 1 LESSON \$25

ADD-ON 5-PACK LESSONS \$100

Lessons will be scheduled on the school's arrival dates.

CARVER CASH

Blue Mountain is cashless at most locations. Carver Cash can be purchased ahead of time, which can be used for anything on the mountain.

HOW BLUE'S PROGRAM WORKS



- Once your portal is set up, you may register yourself then add your children in our system. Once this is complete you will select your products and make payment. The group portal will close for registration on October 31st, 2023.
- Your group leader is your primary contact for questions on the program and products.
- Season passes should not be shared with anyone for any reason.
- Our property is cashless so we encourage you to "load" our Carver
 Cash gift cards in the portal for your children to make purchasing food
 on the property simple.

SKI PATROL & REFUND POLICY

THERE ARE 3 SKI PATROL LOCATIONS ON THE MOUNTAIN:

- Inside the lower level of the Summit Lodge
- At the top of the Main Street Express Chairlift
- At the bottom of the Main Street Express
 Chairlift

We only issue pro-rated credits for group members that have been injured during the course of the program. Credits will be issued in the form of stored value or a Blue Mountain gift card. A doctor's note must be submitted.

KNOW THE CODE

"Your Responsibility Code" is a set of safety guidelines for skiers/boarders, endorsed by the National Ski Areas Association, which all skiers and riders are expected to adhere to while at Blue Mountain.

- Always stay in control. You must be able to stop or avoid people or objects.
- People ahead or downhill of you have the right-of-way. You must avoid them.
- Stop only where you are visible from above and do not restrict traffic.
- Look uphill and avoid others before starting downhill or entering a trail.
- You must prevent runaway equipment.
- Read and obey all signs, warnings, and hazard markings.
- Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
- You must know how and be able to load, ride and unload lifts safely. If you need assistance, ask the lift attendant.
- Do not use lifts or terrain when impaired by alcohol or drugs.
- If you are involved in a collision or incident, share your contact information with each other and a ski area employee.

Discuss with your children the importance of knowing and understanding the Responsibility Code.
