Team opportunities begin in Grade 6 and extend to varsity sports, which include both middle and upper school athletes.

The Athletic Director is responsible for all elements of the athletic program at the school and within our local and state athletic leagues. They also oversee the coaching program and ensure its alignment with Canterbury's mission and honor code. The Athletic Director reports directly to the Head of School.

- Proven track record of teaching, motivating, and supporting students and adults

The Athletic Director will:

- Oversee the hiring of all coaches in partnership with the Head of School.
- Coordinate all training and onboarding for student athletes and coaches.
- Collaborate with coaches to schedule games, transportation, officials, parents' meetings, and special team events.
- Work with school administrators to coordinate events which foster school spirit and pride.
- Be responsible for enforcing safety procedures related to athletics and staying in compliance with the affiliated athletic conferences.
- Work with the Director of College Counseling to support student athletes pursuing to play at the college level.
- Supervise and monitor student retention strategies within athletics.
- Maintain and ensure compliance with current athletic handbook listing detailed policies and procedures.
- Communicate all pertinent information in a timely manner.
- Monitor and evaluate athletic events.
- Perform duties as assigned to support student athletics, the school community, and the school's mission and core values.
