TIPS FOR SUCCESS

Help your child make their journey to college successful and affordable by following these tips provided by the Arizona Commission for Postsecondary Education:

- Make college the expectation, talk about it early and often
- Start saving early with a 529 college savings plan and involve your child

The Arizona Family College Savings Plan is a state sponsored 529 plan designed to provide parent, grandparent or future student an opportunity to save for educational expenses in a taxdeferred manner. The State of Arizona also provides annual Arizona state income tax deduction for 529 plan contributions of up to \$2,000 for individual tax filers, and up to \$4,000 for married couples filing jointly.



- Help your child build their volunteer resume
- Take your child to visit your friends' workplaces to provide firsthand experience about varied careers
- Apply to college early
- Explore tuition reduction options
- Encourage your child to declare their major sooner rather than later to avoid taking unnecessary classes and incurring excessive expenses
- Fill out the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as a first step in the financial aid process and access to many scholarships

The table below summarizes the minimum credit requirements for high school graduation in Arizona for the graduating **class of 2013 and beyond**. Please note that school districts and charter schools may, at their discretion, establish additional graduation credit requirements for their students.

- English 4 credits
- Math 4 credits
- Science 3 credits
- Social Studies 3 credits
- Physical Education/Health 1 credit
- CTE/Vocational Ed. or Fine Art 1 credit
- Electives 8 credits


