

Frequently Asked Questions

What are the daily school hours?

 Elementary school begins at 8:30 a.m. and students are dismissed at 3:30 p.m.

What special classes do students in K-5 attend?

 Students attend each special once a week for 50 minutes. The specials are Art, Gym, Music, Media Tech (computers) and Media Lit (library/book checkout).

How long are lunch and recess?

• Students have 40 minutes of combined lunch and recess times daily.



What is the food service program like?

- Breakfast served daily from 8:05-8:30 a.m. \$1.25 full pay; \$0.30 reduced.
- Hot and cold lunch options are available daily. Lunch menus are distributed monthly and available on the district website.
- Lunch pricing is \$2.25 for full pay; \$0.40 for reduced, and free options are available after completing the Free & Reduced Lunch Application.

What are typical class sizes?

• Class sizes vary from 24-30 students per class.

What supports are available for students?

- Literacy supports are provided to students who qualify from instructional aides, reading specialists, and additional classroom support.
- School social work, speech and language, EL services, and special education services are available for students who meet qualifying criteria.

What is your behavior management system?

 All elementary schools in Allen Park incorporate Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) principles in K-5. This model promotes the teaching of expectations through a 4:1 positive feedback process.

What opportunities exist for parent involvement?

 All elementary schools have active PTAs. Participation in school events is encouraged. Opportunities to volunteer in classrooms are also available across the grade levels.

What opportunities do students have for extracurricular activities?

 After-school activities vary slightly from school to school, but students have many opportunities to get involved in a variety of activities.

How do you communicate with families?

 Each school maintains a family blog with news and information sent out regularly to parents. Principals and teachers also communicate through text groups and eblasts.

We know that you are eager to be a part of the Allen Park Public Schools family. However, we are not able to give individual tours in the spring, as our support and administrative staff are actively engaged in working with students and teachers during the school day.
