### **Competition Season Fees:**

1st Grade - 8th Grade athletes interested in competition cheer must also be registered for football season cheer to compete. Kindergarten cheerleaders do not compete.

**\$250/ Residents and non-Residents**

Football season fees include game uniform rental, cheer shoes (not for flag), game day and October breast cancer awareness bows, practice and homecoming t-shirts. Competition season fees include athlete admission to two ICA competitions, professional choreography, competition music, competition bow, and indoor practice space. **Families are responsible for purchasing warm-up suits and competition uniforms if needed.**

***Additionally, each Family must participate in the annual fundraiser at the start of the season. This year we will be selling Double Good Popcorn. Each athlete is responsible for selling \$300 of popcorn or can choose the buyout option.***
