### SAFETY MESSAGE FROM OFFICER GREGORY

Parents, please review some additional details regarding the parking reminder that is shared weekly in the Chatter.

Be advised of the Carmel city parking ordinance 8-48:(f) No person shall Park a motor vehicle within a roadway segment, located within the City's corporate limits and within two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet of any Carmel-Clay School property, from 7:00 a.m. EST to 5:00 p.m. EST, Monday through Friday, while Carmel-Clay Schools are in session, and where "No Parking or Idling" signs, or an equivalent thereof, have been installed by the City of Carmel.

This ordinance applies to everyone, and no one is exempt unless they have a residential permit. The residential permit information can be found on the CPD website or contact CPD's records department.

We have received a complaint from one of the residents and want to ensure these circled areas are in compliance with the ordinance.



#### PARKING

A new city ordinance now restricts using neighborhood streets near school property as a school drop off alternative. If you are using a car to get children to/from school, please follow the procedure to bring them in/pick up on school property in the lot to the east of the school/facing Hazel Dell Pkwy.

#### CARPOOL
