Curriculum & Requirements

Students must pass a minimum of two consecutive years of the same language at MUHS for graduation. Courses taken elsewhere will not satisfy the graduation requirement.



Course Selection Information

If you wish to take a language as a freshman, please select a course in Skyward. Use the table below to help you decide on a course:

What is your background in the target language?	Path you should select
If you have not taken a course in the language before	Choose a level 1 course (German 1, Latin 1, or Spanish 1)
If you speak the language at home	Choose German Testing, Latin Testing, or Spanish Testing <i>AND</i> plan to take the placement test
If you have taken a course in the language before <i>OR</i> would like to be considered for placement in a higher level	Choose German Testing, Latin Testing, or Spanish Testing <i>AND</i> plan to take the placement test

***If you are unsure of placement, it is recommended that you take the test rather than simply repeating level 1 when it may not be necessary.*
