

An enrollment mailer will be arriving to all Lawndale homes and areas around our FDR and Twain schools to inform families about our programs and enrollment period.






### **Celebrating Black History Month**

# **Business- Construction Change Order**



#### Rogers Admin Building:

- Changer order to address additional asbestos that was discovered.
- The contractor had to build a temporary wall to facilitate the mounting of a rack. This rack was intended to house the IT equipment for the school.
- IT equipment had to be relocated to remove the tiles that had asbestos.
- Change order amount: \$2577



### **Business- Measure EE Bond Issuance**



- Measure EE passed in 2020.
