## **Graduation Participation and Celebration**

In order to participate in graduation on May 26, 2021, all course grades from outside sources must be submitted to the MHS Counseling Office prior to graduation. See Mrs. Davis in the counseling office for specific dates.

The 2021 MHS Graduation Ceremony will be held on May 26 at 6:30 P.M. at the MHS football stadium. This will be a rain or shine event, so please prepare for all types of weather. Currently we can provide eight (8) tickets per senior; however, we hope to increase that amount, and we will notify seniors and their parents as soon as we know. MHS is planning for the best, but please remember that our plans can change based on circumstances beyond our control. Below are the times and locations.

Cap and gown delivery: early May at MHS-- we do have new colors and designs for this year, so students must order a cap and gown through Jostens.

**Senior breakfast:** 9 A.M. May 26 at the MHS stadium

Graduation rehearsal for seniors: 11 A.M. May 26 at the MHS football stadium—this is required if students plan to walk during the evening ceremony. Seniors who do not rehearse can not walk. Senior class picture: 5:15 P.M. May 26 at the MHS stadium bleachers on the visitors' side—students who are not seated by 5:15 will not be included in the picture.

**Graduation ceremony:** 6:30 P.M. May 26 at the MHS football stadium

**Graduation reception:** 8:00 P.M. May 26 at the MHS courtyard (tentative plans include photo booths

and food trucks)
