Counselor Corner

Mill Creek Families,

I am excited for a fun and exciting year with all of the students, staff, and families at Mill Creek Elementary! As the school counselor I want all of you to be aware of the counseling services that are provided at our school.

Individual counseling services: these services are short-term and crisis-based. Individual students may be referred by parents/guardians, teachers, and other school staff members. Students can also refer themselves as issues arise during the school day. As a reminder school counseling services differ from therapy, which focuses on the long-term wellbeing of the child, and referrals can be made by me as requested.

Small group counseling services: small groups focused on different topics such as anger management, conflict resolution, friendship skills, and executive functioning, are offered at our school. Teachers may request that children attend groups or you may request this as parent. These groups are held on a needs basis and at times that don't interfere with core academic instruction,

Classroom guidance lessons: all classrooms at Mill Creek Elementary receive a guidance lesson once a month. This year the topics that will be addressed are conflict management, healthy/unhealthy choices, giving/bucket filling, self-esteem, kindness, growth mindset, managing feelings, test anxiety, and career exploration.

Again, I am excited to be at Mill Creek and support your child(ren) in any way that I can! If you have any questions about what I will be covering this year in guidance lessons or about any counseling services in general, please don't hesitate to reach out to me. I look forward to working with the entire Mill Creek community this 2018-2019 school year!
