Retaliation. Retaliation against any person for the exercise of rights under Title IX or to interfere with those rights in any way is strictly prohibited and will subject the violator to disciplinary action. The identity of any person who has made a report or complaint of sexual harassment or who is the alleged perpetrator of sexual harassment will be confidential unless otherwise required or permitted by law. Complaints alleging retaliation may be filed according to the grievance processes established in Board of Education Policies 1740/4010 and 1750/7220.

Confidentiality. The District will keep confidential the identity of any individual who has made a report or formal complaint of sexual harassment, any complainant, any respondent, and any witness, except as may be permitted or required by law, or as necessary to carry out the investigation and proceeding in this matter.
