## About Us

The Idaho RADAR Center provides substance misuse and mental health resources free to Idaho residents. The center, a Boise State University program, is administered by the Institute for the Study of Behavioral Health and Addiction. Center operation relies on grants and sponsors.

RADAR acts as a clearinghouse of print and electronic information from federal partners including the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA), the National Institute on Drug Abuse (NIDA), the National Institute on Mental Health (NIMH), and the Centers for Disease Control (CDC).

The RADAR Center also operates a lending library which contains DVDs, prevention and treatment curricula, and other materials that patrons can borrow. DVDs can be borrowed for up to 3 weeks and curriculum for up to 8 weeks. These items can be returned in person or by mail.
