

## **Progressive Math Binder Mrs Robbins**

**For progressive math class you will need a one inch binder with five pocket dividers. You will need graph paper for your binder. You will need your math binder every day in class starting Monday.**

**First in your binder will be the class outline.  
Second will be the grading rubric.**

**Then the following sections: Your binder will be divided in five sections.**

### **Section one: Vocabulary**

**Will be organized by chapter. I will provide vocabulary charts, it will be your homework to fill them in completely. They will be graded each quarter.**

### **Section two: Notes**

**In class we will take notes, and some days I will provide notes for you to insert into your binder.**

### **Section three: CPM Classwork**

**Most classwork from the CPM math book will be done collaboratively but each student must do written work. This work will be stamped and checked every Wednesday.**

### **Section four: Math Concepts**

**On our shorter class days, Wednesdays, we will be working on math concepts. This may be short videos, flip books, projects etc. These items will go here.**

### **Section five: Homework**

**All CPM homework will go here. It will be stamped on the day it is due and recorded on Wednesdays in the grade book.**

**I will keep a Math Binder also for you to reference if you are absent to see what you missed. There will be an absent bin with copies of anything that was handed out.**

**Binders will receive a final grade each quarter.**
