## Overview

- Ace it! programs are taught in small groups with a maximum student-to-teacher ratio of 8:1. This ensures students receive personal attention and have the opportunity for teamwork.
- Summative assessments are used to determine student placement and measure academic growth.

- Teachers provide direct and explicit instruction with immediate feedback and strategic questioning.

## SUMMARY

- Sylvan is servicing 83 students over 6 campuses.
- The range of grade levels has been 2 -8. Depending on grade level, skills mastered have ranged from phonics to comprehension and vocabulary.
- Proficiency scores gauge where a student places, after a lesson, on a specific skill. The score ranges from 1(Below Basic) to 3(Proficient).
- The average proficiency score across campuses is 2.4. This denotes that students are moving from below basic to proficient. Hence, learning gaps are being mastered.
- The average attendance so far is 7.8 sessions. Continued attendance will result in more skills being mastered.



## SUMMARY

- 2<sup>nd</sup> graders have been mastering phonics skills such as letter blends and basic comprehension such as story structure.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> graders have been mastering advanced phonics such as silent letters. They have also been mastering comprehension skills such as facts and details.
- 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> graders have been mastering comprehension skills such as main idea, point of view, and author's argument.
- 6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> graders have been mastering more advanced comprehension skills as well as vocabulary. Some of these skills include non-fiction texts, implied main ideas, and context clues for vocabulary.
