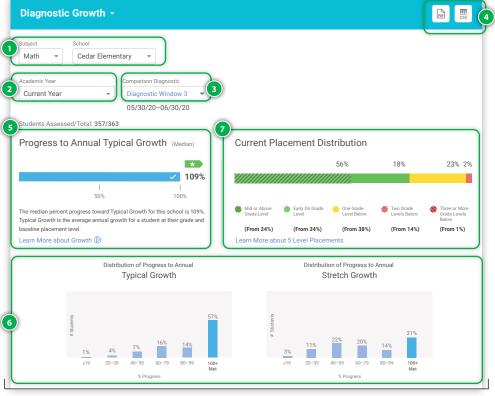

Understanding Growth in i-Ready:

Typical Growth and Stretch Growth measures are provided for each student based on their placement on their baseline Diagnostic assessment of the year.

Typical Growth is the average annual growth for students at that grade and baseline placement level.

Stretch Growth is an ambitious, but attainable, level of annual growth that puts students who are below grade level on a path toward proficiency and students who are on grade level on a path toward advanced proficiency levels.

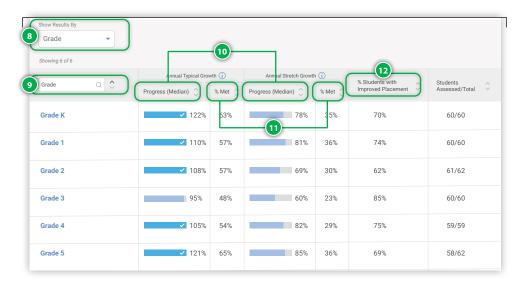
