The Caswell County Board of Education met in a special called meeting on Thursday, June 1, 2023, at the Gunn Memorial Library in Yanceyville, NC. I. A. CALL TO ORDER

On June 1, 2023 at a properly specially called and properly noticed special meeting of The Caswell County Board of Education, the Board discussed and took action regarding matters involving specific personnel.
