The View from the Sidelines: Remembering Vaughn Simmons (Class of 1983)

Beginning in 1971, continuing into the early 1990's, I was chaplain to the PHS varsity football teams, supporting them in prayer and presence in the locker room and on the sidelines. For almost 50 years, from the sidelines of life, I continue connection with these young men at PHS



sports events, on social media and alumni gatherings. They have become police officers, social workers, community activists, corporate officers, teachers and coaches (many of whom returned to serve at PHS). One observation that resonates in my heart is appreciation for the deep bonds of friendship among these men, with roots going back to elementary and junior high school.

The varsity football team of 1983 stands out as one of the most remarkable teams in PHS history. Two team leaders are Stacy Harvey and Vaughn Simmons. I remember a CIF Playoff football game between PHS and South High School in Torrance. For some reason, Vaughn Simmons, an outstanding tailback, did not play in the first half. PHS was not doing well by half-time. As the third quarter began, Vaughn ran on to the field. A thunderbolt of energy surged through the team. Vaughn electrified the crowd as he ran for touchdowns and Stacy guided the team to a great victory. Vaughn Simmons was a blue-chip prospect in field and track and All-American high school football player, destined to receive a scholarship to the University of Southern California.

My friendship with Vaughn grew as we were founding board members of the Pasadena High School Alumni Association. We met at the board meeting every month and I admired his quiet wisdom and commitment to building bridges among alumni. He and Stacy continued to have an energizing presence. Sadly, Stacy Harvey died a few years ago and Vaughn died suddenly in July. The Alumni Association celebrates with gratitude these two Bulldog champions.



Notable Alumni - Zephyr Moore Ramsey Class of 1909

One of the first Black women to be admitted to the Bar in California, Zephyr Moore Ramsey was the author of an essay, "Law and Its Call to Women," which has been studied in American law schools for many years.

Zephyr graduated from Pasadena High School in 1909 and Howard University School of Law in 1922. Her first teaching job was at Livingston College in North Carolina. She had a law practice in St. Louis, Missouri from 1925-1930. She worked for the Federal Emergency Relief Administration during the Depression. After World War II, Ramsey returned to Los Angeles to practice family law.

In 1949, she was legal advisor to Black real estate brokers in Pasadena. This would have been a challenging time, because Black families seeking to purchase homes faced restrictive covenants in neighborhoods that would not sell to Jewish and Black families. She was a formidable force for justice and inclusion. She died in 1984, at the age of 91.


