lessons. Each student will receive:

- Swim Suit
- Fresh Towels Daily
- Water Safety Workbook
- Transportation
- Free Family Swim Pass





Students will learn ways to be safe around pools, the beach and other bodies of water.

No child should ever drown, but the fact is that 10 people drown every day in the United States. According to Pediatrics & Adolescent Medicine, participation in formal swim lessons like the ones children take in the **Rose Bowl Aquatics Challenge** teach skills that can save lives and can reduce the likelihood of childhood drowning by 88%.

The program at the Rose Bowl Aquatics Center is designed to achieve three goals:

- (1) Teach our students ways to be safe around water
- (2) Provide swimming instruction so our students will gain skills for a lifetime of healthy recreation
- (3) Help students and families learn how to access health and recreation programs available year-round at the RBAC



Our families are invited to visit the RBAC for five FREE recreational swim sessions!

Each student will receive a Family Swim Pass good for five free recreational swim sessions. We hope every family will take this opportunity to visit the RBAC, learn about programs for people of all ages and all abilities, picnic in the park and have fun. Not only will everyone have a wonderful time, but parents will have an opportunity to see how much their children are learning.
