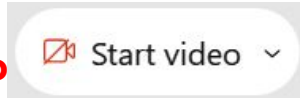

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Overview of California School Dashboard



What is the California School Dashboard?

- The California School Dashboard (Dashboard) is an online tool designed to help communities across the state access important information about kindergarten through grade twelve schools and districts.
- The Dashboard features easy-to-read reports on multiple measures of school success
- Included are six state indicators and seven local indicators
- The 2023 Dashboard represents the second data point post-COVID-19 school closures
- The results should be used in conjunction with other local data on student performance and progress to provide a more detailed, holistic picture

What is measured on the Dashboard?

State Measures

- Academic Performance
 - SBAC ELA
 - SBAC Math
- Chronic Absenteeism
- English Learner Progress
- College/Career Readiness
- High School Graduation Rate
- Suspension Rate

Local Measures

- Basic Conditions
- Implementation of Academic Standards
- School Climate Surveys
- Parent Involvement and Family Engagement
- Access to Courses

What is the Dashboard Used For?

- **Eligibility for Support**

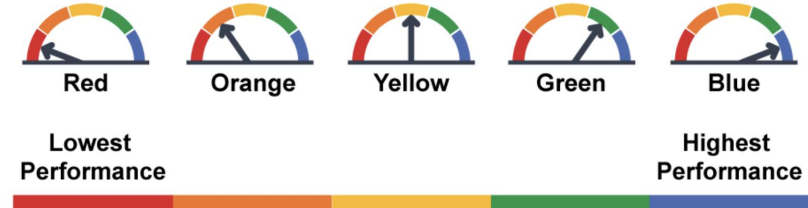
- Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) Differentiated Assistance
 - PUSD met eligibility criteria for English Learners, Foster Youth
 - Pupil Achievement (CAASPP)
 - Pupil Engagement (Graduation Rate)
- Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)
 - *Comprehensive Support & Improvement (CSI)**
 - Graduation rate < 68% for 3+ years
 - Title I school, all or all but one school-wide indicators at lowest performance level (Red, Very Low)
 - *Additional Targeted Support & Improvement (ATSI)**
 - One or more student groups for two or more consecutive years meet CSI criteria performance levels

- **Awards and Distinctions**

- **Grant Opportunities**

Changes for CA School Dashboard 2023

- All state measures have a color in 2023, except for College/Career Indicator (CCI) which will be status only (cell bars)

How does the Dashboard display performance?



For State measures, performance colors are based on two factors:

- **Status:** current year results (2022-2023 SY)
- **Change:** whether results improved from the prior year (2021-2022 SY)

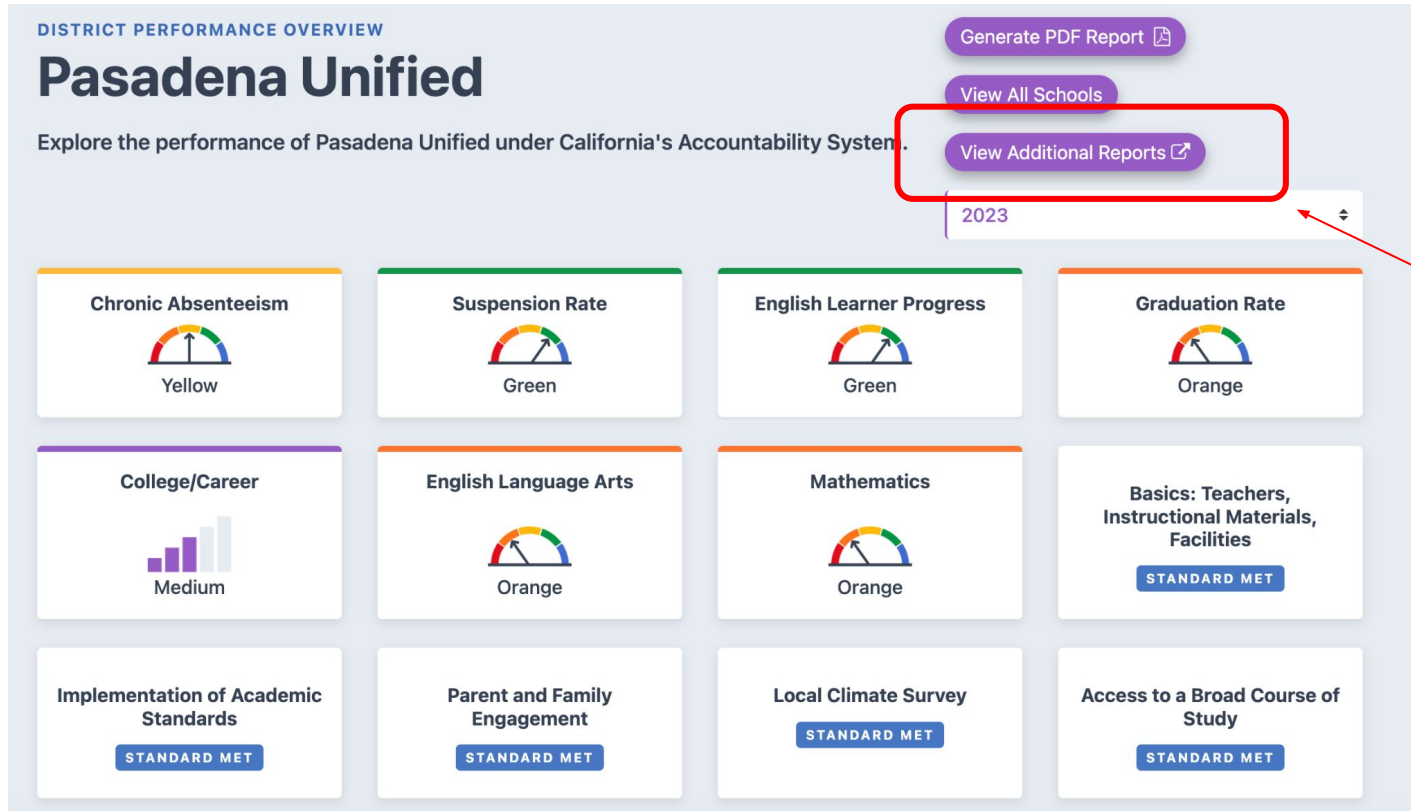

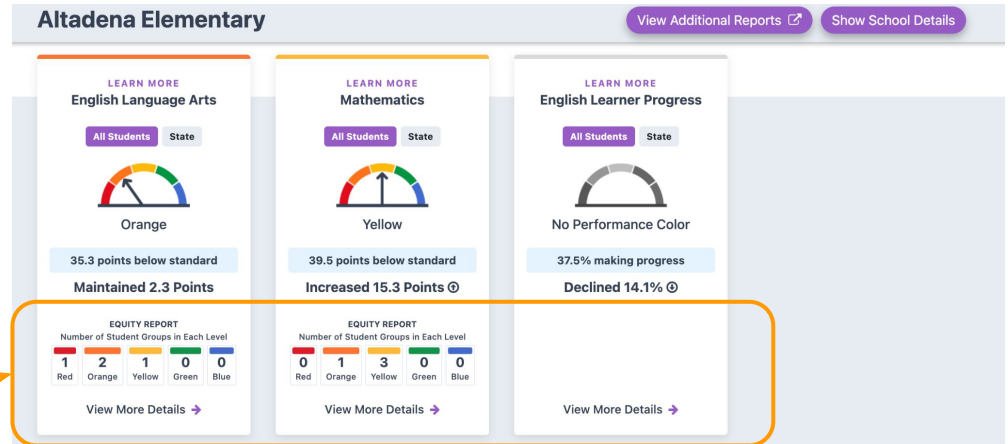
What the 2023 Dashboard Looks Like



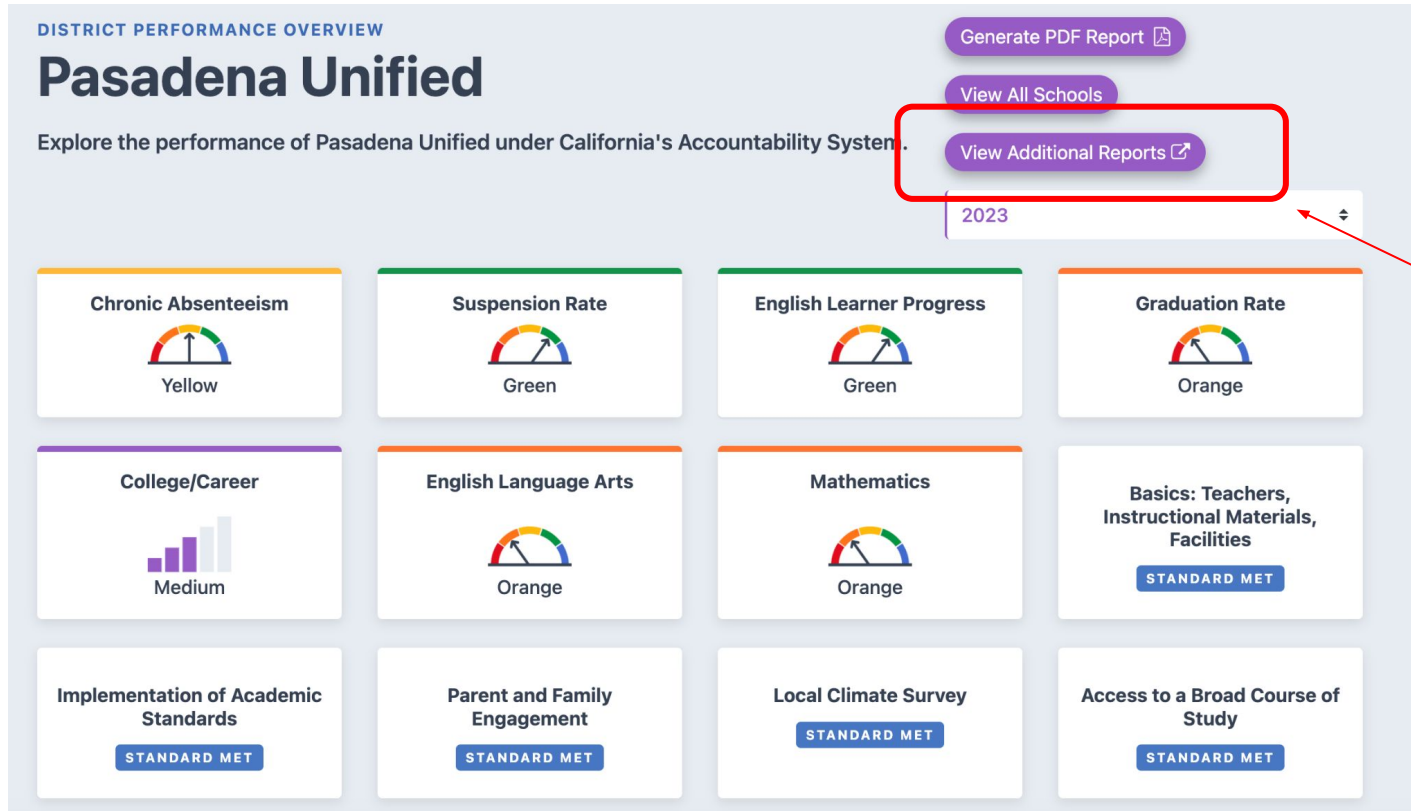

- Click “View More Details”

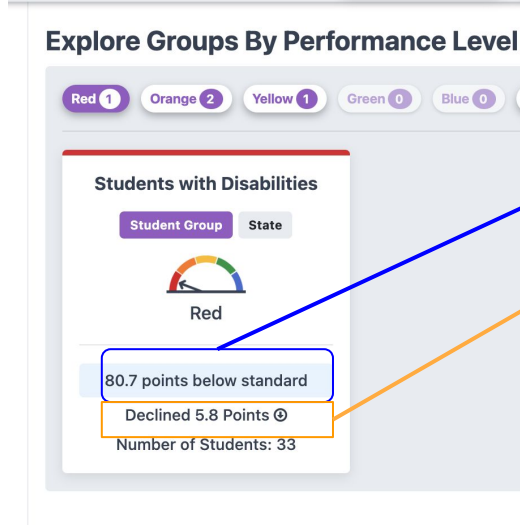

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How can we use this in our SSC meetings?



Using Dashboard Data in SPSA

- Helps to provide detailed information on student performance and progress (along with other information)
- Use data as part of identifying student needs
- In 2024-2025 SPSA, identifying student groups in “red” performance category and connect specific actions and metrics to student outcomes
- Developing goals in 2024-2025 SPSA
- Identify any additional data to help complete accurate, holistic view of student achievement and performance
