In addition, please contact your school nurse so that an Action Plan can be developed to meet any medical needs you may have, as well as a private location for lactating students.

Know Your Rights

1. You have the same right as any student to continue your education, and the same responsibility to attend school.
2. You have the right to stay at your current school, and you cannot be excluded from any school activity or program for which you qualify.
3. You have a right to have your confidentiality respected.
4. You have a right to request that your school make reasonable accommodations to make sure you can participate in all school programs and activities.
5. Enrollment at any other program specially designed for pregnant or parenting students, must be completely voluntary on your part.
6. You have a right to excused absences for illness or medical appointments for yourself or your child.
7. You must be allowed to make up work missed during an excused absence.
8. Get the information and support you need to stay in school and graduate.
9. You have a right to get help if you feel you have been treated unfairly due to your pregnancy or parenting.
