Graduate Portfolio Tasks -- with deadlines for 2018-2019

Suggested order and deadlines/steps to completion:

August 13:

- 1) Choose two to three artifacts that represent most nodes of the graduate profile (critical thinker, creative/innovative thinker, communicator, collaborator, prepared for college/career, culturally competent citizen).
 - One artifact must be a 5-7 page essay, researched and with citations (citation page included in page count).
 - One artifact must be a creative project.
 - If your creative project is not collaborative, it is recommended to add a third project that is collaborative (like the Innovation Project).

September 4:

- 2) Fill out an artifact reflection sheet for each artifact.
 - Upload each artifact to your your PowerLearning ePortfolio

September 17:

- 3) Write a 2 ½ to 3 page "graduate reflection" about your learning and skills that show your progress. Use your artifacts to show how you have grown over your high school years.
 - Upload your overall "graduate reflection" onto your PowerLearning page.

October 1:

4) Create your presentation.

October 10:

5) Practice your presentation with a mentor.

October 12:

6) Give your presentation in front of a panel (including Marshall faculty, students, and possibly community members)
