## 3 Steps to Becoming a PUSD Substitute Teacher:

1. Apply for a Certificate of Clearance with the California Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC).
2. Submit an employment application with PUSD for Substitute Teaching.
3. Obtain an “Emergency 30-Day Substitute Permit” from the CTC concurrently while you work.
