### PASADENA UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (PUSD) CITIZENS' OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE (COC) MEETING DRAFT Meeting Minutes for January 25, 2023

Meeting was held in hybrid format: in-person at Ed Center and online via WebEx

- Meeting was called to order at 6:29 pm Present:
  - A. COC members: Angela Uriu, Eliza Jane Whitman, John Robinson, Paul Nerenberg, Stephen Aquino, Wayne Hammack
  - B. PUSD staff: Dr. Leslie Barnes, Leonard Hernandez, and Anahit Azarian
  - C. PUSD Board liaison: Kim Kenne, Jennifer Hall Lee
  - D. SafeworkCM: Michael Dobrotin
  - E. There were also one unidentified member of the public in-person.
- II. Public Comment There were no public comments.
- III. Approval of the December 2022 Meeting Minutes The minutes were approved (1st JR and 2nd AG)
- IV. LACTSA Homework for COC Members One page handout is in the COC meeting package and was discussed in the November 2022 COC meeting. PUSD shows a "yes" on item #1 and #9 but Items #2 to #8 were a no.
- V. Review of Measure TT and Measure O related Board Reports There were eight (8) Board Reports for this meeting including:
  - A. BR 1602-F Approval to award contract to TBP Architects for the design and procurement of DSA approval relocation of three (3) additional classroom buildings from Allendale Elementary to Altadena Arts Magnet School.
    - 1. Different architect who did the previous relocation of two (2) classroom project?
      - a) Yes
    - 2. Was the \$3,100 topo survey required?
      - a) No the school as topo available
    - 3. Why was there no bid support, construction administration and closeout like BR 1603-F in this bid?
      - a) Those services are included within the \$16,000
    - 4. Rates in the Architect proposal expired on 12/31/2022. Are they good with the rates or will they need to be increased?
      - a) Architect is good with the rates as it is lump sum project.
    - 5. Excludes path of travel and solar panels. Is that ok?

- a) Yes ok as path of travel not changing and solar panels will be relocated by the solar vendor.
- 6. Board report write up says approval for architectural work and should be architectural and engineering?
  - a) Yes and future BR will be take architecture and engineering into consideration within the BR write up.
- 7. The purchase order 1904 was cut in December 2022. Was this a ratification?
  - a) Facilities will follow up with PUSD Board member Ms. Kenne
- B. BR 1603-F Approval to award contract for Architectural Design Services for shade structure installation at Washington ES, Madison ES, McKinley ES, Hamilton ES, Norma Coombs ES and Field ES.
  - 1. Board report write up says approval for architectural work and should be architectural and engineering?
    - a) Yes and future BR will be take architecture and engineering into consideration within the BR write up.
  - 2. Fee structure on this Architectural firm.
    - a) All bidding is lump sum so the hourly rates are not impacting the projects.
  - 3. Can we have a table of the bidders in the BR package as to how the proposals, interviewers and pricing were rated?
    - a) Yes this can be added in future BR packages.
  - 4. The close out fee seems very high.
    - a) The architectural pricing is not-to-exceed and the close out was 25% which is time & material.
  - 5. Due to the not-to-exceed will this eliminate change orders?
    - a) Potentially. Transfer of the risk portfolio with a high close out percentage.
  - 6. Will all these summer school program at these schools be impacted?
    - a) The summer school program committees have been notified to eliminate conflict with construction.
  - 7. Will there be utility conflicts?
    - a) Under general conditions is to confirm via underground survey.
  - 8. Why were these 6 locations picked?
    - a) All have minimal path of travel from public right-of-way to the shade structure, office to the shade structure and restroom to the shade structure.
  - 9. Site specific information is missing. How certain are we?
    - a) Six sites had preliminary site survey and that is what was bid with path of travel, ADA upgrades to parking and restrooms.
  - Ms. Kenne indicated that this is a separate agenda item and is in the COC package to answer questions on the shade structure program
- C. BR 1605-F Approval to proceed with award of Turnkey Design Build contract to Southland for the Sierra Madre ES power service and Central Plant upgrade.
  - 1. D/B only shows Southland (who is architect)?

- a) Facilities is working on architect and some will be done in-house.it is being done under Assembly Bill 4217 so direct awarded.
- 2. Reading but background does not tell the public how Facilities go to the recommendation to Southland
  - a) It was through AB 4217 which has three contractors listed and due to Southlands track record was selected.
- 3. Besides SCE and District. Did we get a 3<sup>rd</sup> party to reassess?
  - a) District staff, another consultant and Southland all reviewing and confirmed this is the correct upgrade for PUSD.
- 4. Under Fiscal Impact the not to exceed is \$3,003,472 but should be \$3,005,330.
  - a) Understood and will update the PUSD Board.
- 5. Has the ESSER funding request been submitted to avoid Measure O funding?
  - a) Dr. Barnes indicated that the ESSER funding request has been submitted.
- D. BR 1609-F Approval to proceed with preparation of bids and procurement for the Loma Alta ES Roofing Program Phase II HVAC Replacements.
  - 1. Notice there is no design?
    - a) Remove and replace project. No design required.
  - 2. Does the roofing contractor cover the curbing for HVAC
    - a) It is on the HVAC Contractor not roofing Contractor.
  - 3. Has the ESSER funding request been submitted to avoid Measure O funding?
    - a) Dr. Barnes indicated that the ESSER funding request has been submitted.
  - 4. Were there any leaks with the big rains?
    - a) The leaks issues were greatly minimized.
  - 5. How many HVAC units are there?
    - a) Job walk is 1/26/2023 so unit cost will be finalized
  - 6. Will ducts be replaced or cleaned or thermostat be replaced?
    - a) There was some contingency that can be used to address those issues if required.
- E. BR 1610-F Approval to proceed with preparation of bids and procurement for the Don Benito Administration Building Roofing Program Phase II HVAC Replacements.
  - The Fiscal Impact should indicated that ESSER funding should be pursued.
    - a) It will be changed that ESSER funding could be pursed.
  - 2. Has the ESSER funding request been submitted to avoid Measure O funding?
    - a) Dr. Barnes indicated that the ESSER funding request has been submitted.
- F. BR 1611-F Approval to proceed with preparation of bids and procurement for the PUSD Classroom Security Door Lockset Replacement Project.
  - 1. Has this worked been started?
    - a) Four sites were completed for security cameras, classroom security door locksets and automated entrances.

- 2. What is the timeline for implementation of the new locksets?
  - a) Still needs to be scoped and go out to bids so will get schedule later.
  - b) Definitely be phased and maybe a school at a time.
- 3. On the list by school site. Doors in bad shape to change the locks?
  - a) Might required that the door needs to be replaced first and is not included in the Fiscal Impact not-to-exceed.
  - b) There is 10% contingency
- 4. Sierra Madre Middle School not on the list. Did we put these types of lockset in when it was built?
  - a) Facilities does not know and needs follow up.
- 5. Closed schools are highlighted but are they included in the total?
  - a) Sites being used will be changed but closed schools not being used will not change.
  - b) Scope will be refined and get bid prices.
- G. BR 1612-F Approval to proceed with preparation of bids and procurement for the Charter School Classroom Security Door Lockset Replacement Project.
  - 1. Same spreadsheet but different worksheet?
    - a) It was the same spreadsheet but different workshops.

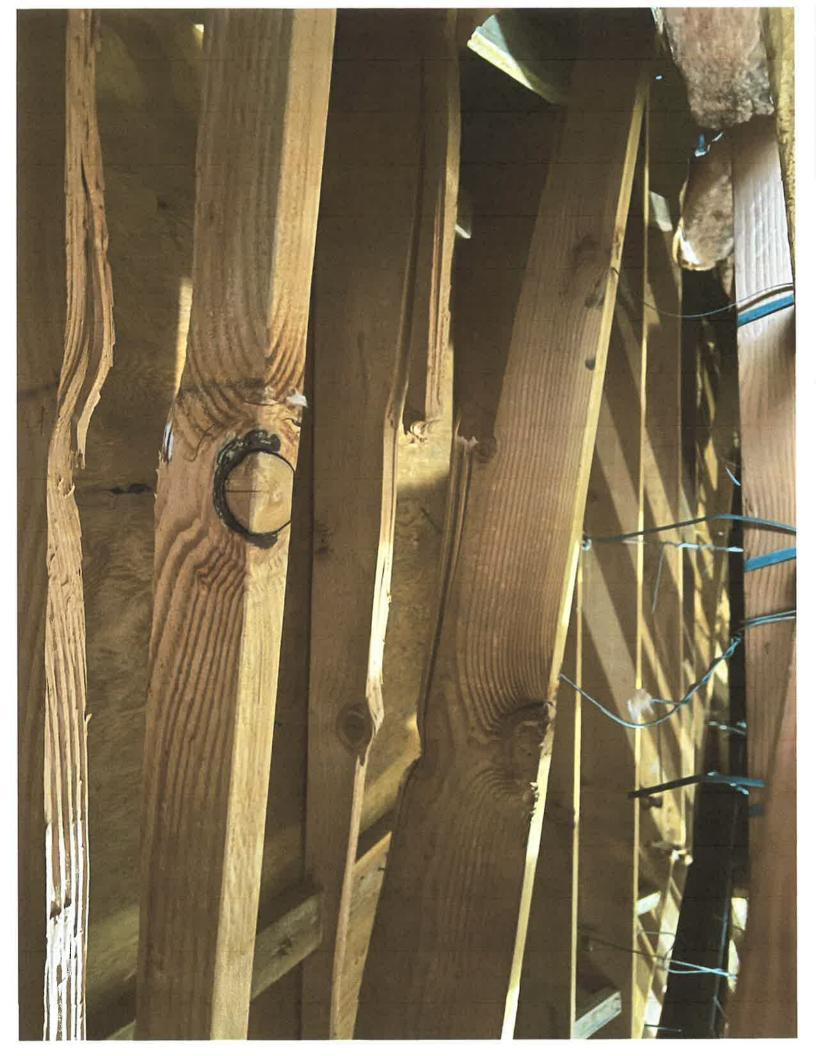

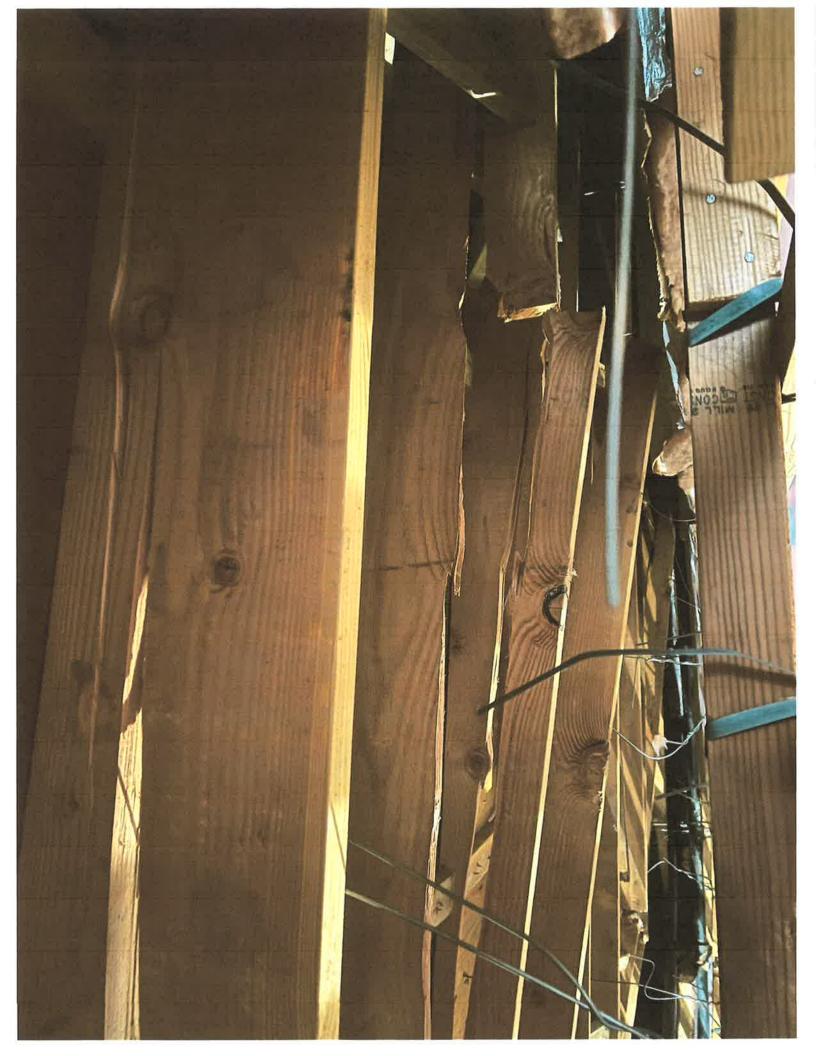

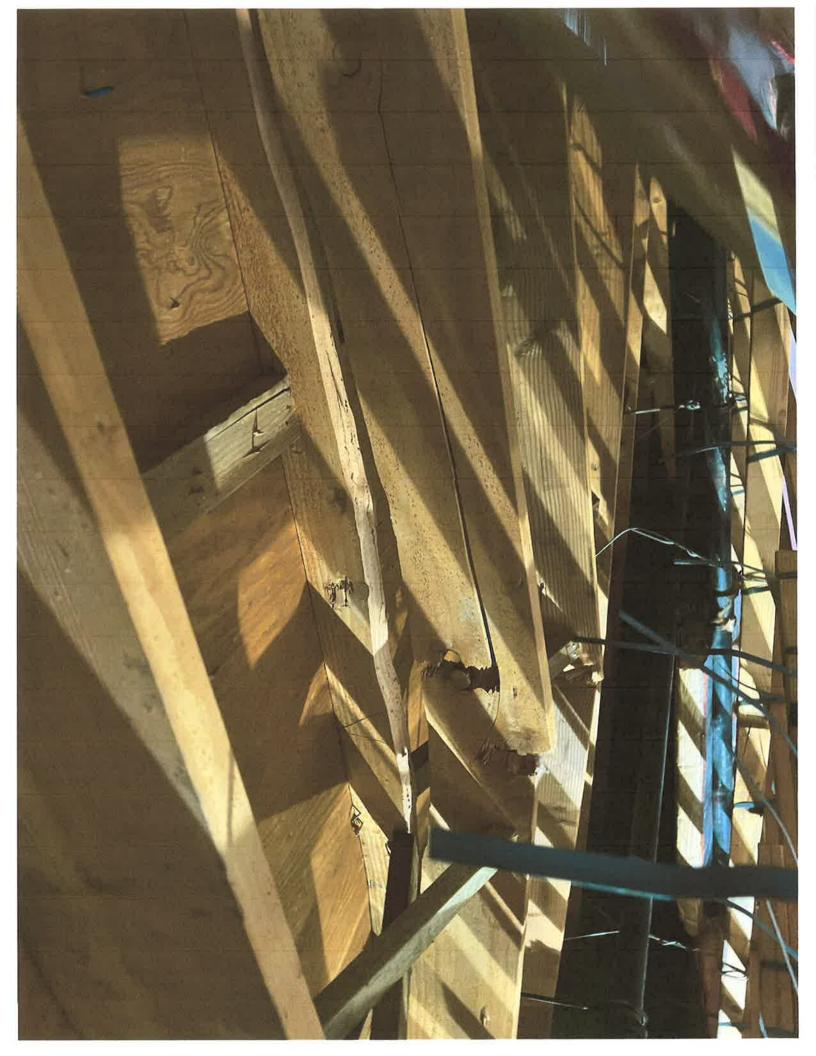
