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## SCHOOL SITE COUNCIL MINUTES

**Tuesday, February 1, 2022, at 3:30 p.m. at San Pasqual Union School**

Meeting called to order at 3:35pm.

Members Legge-Beekman, Higgins, Mokhtari, Carroll, McKay, Read-Smith, Burroughs, Lee and P Hansen present. Members Dussia, Graves, J Hansen, and Bronson not present.

Guests welcomed and the pledge of allegiance recited.

Hearing of the public. No comments shared.

Member Legge-Beekman motioned to approve agenda and minutes. Member Carroll seconded the motion.

Anna Schen, Program Specialist from the San Diego County Office of Education gave a presentation on the [Positive Behavior Intervention & Supports \(PBIS\)](#).

Mrs. Lee, Assistant Principal presented the [2022 Comprehensive School Safety Plan SPUSD](#) and the [SPUSD Safe School Plan DRAFT](#).

Principal Burroughs provided an [LCAP Mid-Year Report 2022](#).

Principal Burroughs provided the Principal Report in which he shared the following:

- COVID Update
  - 120 positive cases in January with school impacted and non school impacted.
  - District began group tracing per CDC guidelines
  - New Decision Tree helps to get staff and students back to school in a more timely manner.
  - KN95 masks were provided by SDCOE and will be available to students but not required.
- It is too early to determine how the changes to San Pasqual Academy will affect our District but we are in communication with the decision makers and will continue to provide updates as we receive information.

- Foundation Update
  - The APEX funds will be distributed as follows:
    - 10% of funds raised per class will go back to the teachers to be spend for the classrooms
    - 30% to enrichment programs
    - 30% for Bully Prevention
    - 30% for Sports and Athletics

During Team Input/Discussion, members expressed concerns on the following items:

- Julie Carroll would like some of the “enrichment programs” to include extending library hours
- Adriana Mokatari would like to see a mentor program encouraging older students to work with younger students.
- Kim Read-Smith thanks the District for the ‘gift of time’ by canceling meetings on Thursday’s for February and March. She is excited to start an 8th grade rock band. She also notes that VAPA and DELAC are working together to provide an in-day Cinco de Mayo celebration for the students. She is also working with the high schools to help build relationships particularly in regards to the music department.
