Portfolio Portfolio Development	Create a comprehensive portfolio of work based on a topic that is related to the student's area of focus or work based on the student's field experience.
Field Experience	Complete a field experience or capstone and document the experience in a work-based portfolio specific to the student's area of focus
GPA	3.0 on a 4.0 scale

To be eligible, students need to complete four credits of art and design course work, submit a comprehensive portfolio of work, complete a field experience or capstone, and document the experience to be qualify for the art and design honors certification.

Portfolio- Artwork that is shown in a portfolio documents the student's extensive knowledge and technical, critical-thinking, and creative skills that the student has learned in art and design classes at McNicholas.

Field Experience | Capstone - To complete the field experience criteria, a student must complete a learning experience that is pertinent to their honors portfolio area of focus.

MADE Honors Certification: Portfolio

McNicholas Honors Certification program recognizes students who exceed the minimum graduation requirements through taking rigorous coursework and engaging in vigorous, real-world or capstone experience. The MADE Certification includes a portfolio criterion. Artwork/work that is contained in a portfolio documents the student's extensive knowledge, technical, critical-thinking, and creative skills (representative of the student's MADE honors certification area of focus) that the student has learned. Students must get their portfolios reviewed and validated by the McNicholas Art + Design teachers.
