



## UPPER SCHOOL CURRICULUM AT A GLANCE 2024-25

Each pupil chooses three A level subjects from the following (if you are choosing *Further Maths*, please do not choose *Maths*):

Art and Design	French	Mathematics

Pupils in the Remove (Year 12) are expected to follow an Advanced Electives programme in which they choose two courses over one year that provide an opportunity for them to fire their enthusiasm and become experts in areas that lie just beyond the reach of the normal curriculum.

At the end of the Remove, pupils will complete their Extended Essay or Extended Project Qualification which is assessed in the first term of the Upper Sixth (Year 13).

Pupils in Year 13, in addition to A level subjects, follow a Liberal Studies programme. These courses are taught in conjunction with James Allen's Girls' School and are non-examined.

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
