Essay

Please write a response of at least 500 words to one of the following topics or questions:

- a. Describe an experience with an organization or community group of which you have been a member and explain how you contributed to that group.
- b. Members of your Fisher College class will be faced with many challenges on a local, national, and international level in the years ahead. In your opinion, what is the greatest challenge that your generation will face, and what ideas do you have for dealing with this issue?
- c. Identify one of your career goals, examine how or why you want to achieve this goal, and discuss how you believe that your work at Fisher College will prepare you to reach this goal.

Letters of Recommendation

- Letters of Recommendation from at least 2 High School Faculty Members**
- **If you submitted these with your application for admission, we will include them in your application for the honors program. Any additional letters are welcome, not required.**

(Letters of recommendation from people who are not teachers are only accepted in addition to the required two letters from teachers or with permission from the Honors Program Director.)

In this the letter, the writer should comment on the student's basic writing and math skills, college preparedness, and motivation.
